## **DNR Applications Offline on February 9, 2022**

At noon on Wednesday February 9th, 2022 the DNR Information Technology (IT) staff will shut down the production Oracle server. Once the server has been taken offline, the following application will not be available or will not have access to the Safe Drinking Water Information System (SDWIS):

#### Applications that will be unavailable:

- Direct Report
- Opcert Web
- Lab to State
- SDWIS
- Water Container (including Operator Certification)

#### These applications will not be able to retrieve data from SDWIS:

- Facility Explorer
- laWells
- PWTS
- Water Use
- Wwisard

The DNR IT staff will then replace the current server with the new server. This process is expected to take 3 to 4 hours. Directly after the new server is made available, Water Supply program staff will test to ensure that the new server is working correctly. Applications should be available again on Thursday, February 10.

### **Operator Certification: Continuing Education Opportunities**
