### Reminder: Electronic Permit Notification is Available on WWPIE

Persons interested in individual NPDES and operation permits in Iowa can register, save searches, and receive email notifications on draft and final permits in the the <u>Wastewater Permit information Exchange (WWPIE) database</u>. Registered users can opt to receive email notifications when individual permits are drafted or finalized in a specific search area, so users can be notified of new draft permits or can track permit issuance. For sign up instructions, refer to the WWPIE Registration and Notification Instructions on the <u>NPDES Databases webpage</u> or view the FAQ document in WWPIE.

### Integrated Planning Communities Workshop for Small to Medium-Sized Municipalities

The Environmental Finance Centers (EFCs) in partnership with U.S. EPA are hosting a 90-minute workshop to to provide small to medium-sized municipalities with the information needed to get started with integrated planning. The goals of this workshop are to review action items that can help municipalities get started with integrated planning, introduce municipalities to introductory information aimed to help communities take action, and to participate in small breakout sessions to think through key questions to answer at the beginning stages of getting started. There will be an opportunity to ask questions in the small breakout sessions. Speakers will include Robyn DeYoung, EPA; Evan Kirk, UNC Environmental Finance Center; and Louis McMahon, Lakewood, OH.

The workshop will be hosted as a Zoom webinar on Wednesday April 20, 2022, from 2:00-3:30 PM EST.

The target audience is small to medium-sized communities/municipalities (under 60,000 people) that are interested in getting started with integrated planning and hold an NPDES permit for at least one of the following: combined sewer systems, sanitary sewer

system overflow, Wastewater Treatment Facility (WWTF), MS4 (stormwater), or other Clean Water Act obligations.

## Registration Open for Advanced Industrial Stormwater Training

Mark your calendars and register to attend one of the upcoming "Advanced Topics in Industrial Stormwater Management" online training opportunities. This spring, the Iowa Stormwater Education Partnership (ISWEP) is offering two training sessions to meet demand for stormwater management training.

Industrial and commercial facilities with "stormwater discharge associated with industrial activity" are required to obtain permits, typically known as General Permits #1 and #3. The new advanced training sessions have been developed to expand on specific requirements for General Permit #1 holders in lowa.

#### First Session - Stormwater Pollution Prevention Training for Airport Staff

- The first of the advanced stormwater training sessions will help airport facility staff
  understand their permitting requirements, the major elements of pollution
  prevention plans, and how to implement best management practices. The two
  hour training session will be held on Tuesday, May 3, 2022.
- Who should attend?: Airport personnel including managers, mechanics and maintenance staff and others involved with any activities that could pollute stormwater. This training can satisfy airport employee staff pollution prevention training requirements listed in General Permit #1.
