

Project Description

Work on this project began Jan. 23, 1986. The relocation of Iowa 150 begins at the Buchanan-Fayette County line and proceeds northward 2.3 miles on the regraded Rock Island Railroad abandoned alignment to Third Street S.E. in Oelwein. The four lane highway then curves westward one block and northward four blocks on First Avenue N.E. before curving westward again one block to reconnect with North Frederick Avenue (present lowa 150) at Second Street N.E.
