Lake Anita State Park is 942 acres of rolling loess land with a 171 acre artificial lake nestled inside.

The park is located in northeast Cass County in southwest Iowa. Fishing in the lake for largemouth bass, crappie and bluegill is good to excellent during the year. Other activities and facilities that the area includes are camping, boating, hiking, picnicking and swimming. Mushroom hunting is allowed in the park.

Picnic shelters are available on a first come first serve basis.

Boat motors not exceeding ten horsepower are permitted on the lake.



## LOCATION

Lake Anita is located 3 miles south of Interstate 80 at the Anita interchange.

State park maintenance and operation funds are derived solely from legislative appropriation and receipts from camping and concession revenue, cabin and lodge rental and boat dock fees.

EQUAL RECREATIONAL OPPORTUNITIES: All persons are entitled to full and equal enjoyment of the recreational opportunities, privileges and advantages available in Iowa's great outdoors.

## CAMPING INFORMATION

Lake Anita State Park will accommodate 144 camping units. There are electrical hook-ups available for those who prefer the modern touch. Lake Anita campsites are classified as modern as there are flush toilets and shower facilities available. All camping permits are issued by the park ranger. 
