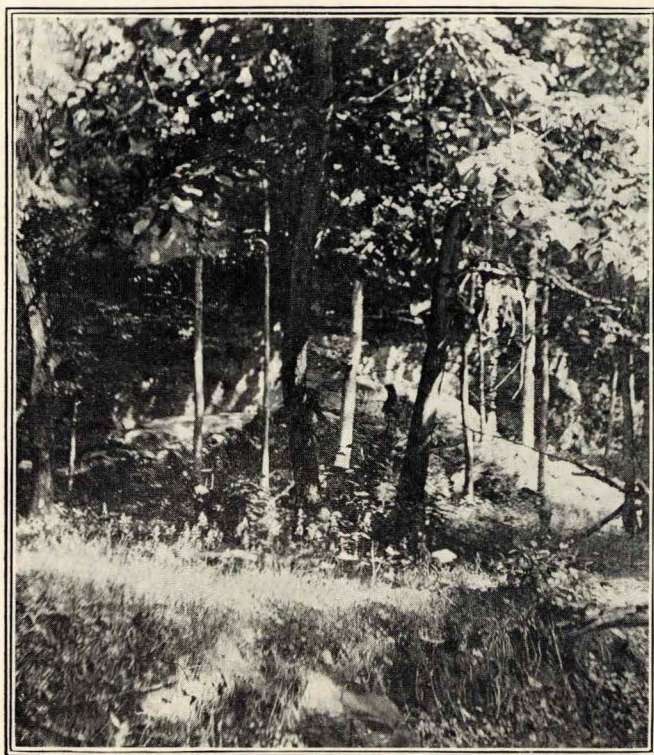

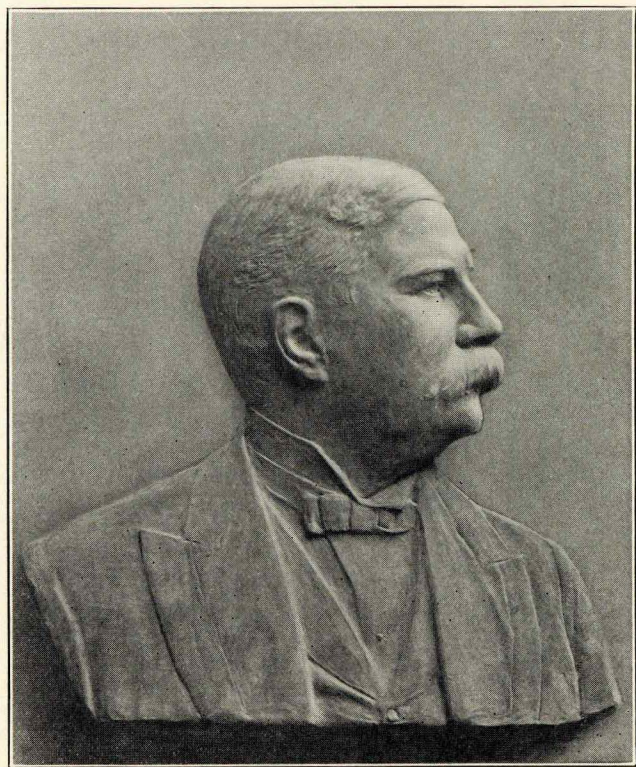

“The miracle of homestead settlement brought to these prairies the best blood of the world’s energies, an heroic generation that, with the rude sermons of poverty and labor, dedicated this ample territory. The men and devoted women who settle a country are the lasting and preferred creditors of every succeeding generation. We will never be able to repay them. The frontier servitude of their experience is beyond the arithmetic of gratitude. May their lives be spared to witness, with their children, the full measure of political, commercial and industrial prosperity to see the country in which their frontier fortunes have been cast filled with an industrious, happy and high-minded people.”
