MULTIPURPOSE TRAIL IS USED BY HIKERS AND HORSEBACK RIDERS IN WARM SEASON AND SNOWMOBILERS AND CROSS COUNTRY SKIERS WHEN UNDER SNOW COVER.

SNOWMOBILES ARE CONFINED TO MARKED TRAILS, ROAD DITCHES AND UNPLOWED ROADWAYS.

AUTOMOBILES AND MOTORCYCLES ARE PROHIBITED OFF ROADWAYS.

CAMPING

ALL CAMPERS MUST SELF REGISTER AT CHECK-IN STATION. CAMP IN DESIGNATED AREAS ONLY.

EQUESTRIAN USERS

CAMPERS: ALL HORSES MUST BE TIED IN HORSE SHELTER OVER NIGHT. THE REASON FOR THIS IS TO PROTECT THE GROUND COVER. HORSES DESTROY THE GROUNDCOVER BY GRAZING AND STOMPING FLYS WHEN TIED FOR LONG PERIODS TO TRAILERS.

Horses are not allowed in NonEquestrian Camping Areas.

Equestrian Day Users must park in Equestrian Day Use
Parking Lot - Not in Equestrian Campground.
