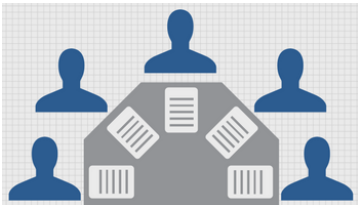
Pop YS Book Club
