INTRODUCTION

Contained in this index are published and unpublished vital statistics and a listing of data items which are retained on individual vital event records.

Included in this publication are:

- Annual published vital statistics, 1950-73
- Unpublished vital statistics
- Special publications
- Unaggregated vital statistics data

Supplements to the index will be published as needed.

The index is designed to assist users in obtaining data and to acquaint them with what data is available. A sample request showing how to use the index follows:

SAMPLE REQUEST

Data Wanted:

Number of resident live births by sex, by age of mother, 1960-73.

Use of the Index:

For the majority of data, start with the most recent year needed and work back. Records for current years are, in general, more complete than earlier years. Therefore, the following steps would be followed to ascertain if the information needed for this sample request can be obtained.

Step 1: Recent Years

- a) Locate "State Vital Statistics, Published in Annual Reports", p. 5.
- b) Under "Live Births:", find "Sex of Child by Age of Mother". Across from this in the column headed "Annual Report" is 1970-, indicating that the information is available from 1970 to the most recent publication.
- Step 2: Past Years
 - a) Find "State Vital Statistics, Published in Annual Reports, 1950-1969",
 p. 10.
 - b) An examination of the listings under "Live Births By:", shows that the sought listing is not present.
- Step 3: Other Sources
 - a) Refer to "State Vital Statistics, Unpublished", p. 17. Under "Live Births By:", there is no listing for sex by age of mother, but there is one for "Color and Sex of Child by Age of Mother" available for 1960, 65, 69, and 70. This category would provide the necessary data.
 - b) Turn to "Special Publications", p. 33. Listed is a report on "The World That Greets Iowa's Infant". However, the data wanted is not there.
- Step 4: Unaggregated Data
 - a) Finally, refer to "Data Collected on Vital Events", p. 37. As previously stated, the data listed here is unaggregated and in most cases data requests will require computer programming.
 - b) The table, "Births, 1959-61, 1965-73" states that birth information is available for 1959-61 and 1965-73, indicating no data is retrievable for 1962-64. For the remaining years, 1961, 1966-68, find the two data items, sex and age of mother. Both items are available.

Requesting the Data: Requests for data can be expedited if a list of data locations is included in your request. For example:

Would like the number of resident live births by sex, by age of mother for 1960-73. Would like age of mother by five-year age groups.

Data available in: Iowa Detailed Report - 1970-73
Unpublished data - 1960, 65, 69

Special request for 1961, 1966-68 Also, if available, - 1962-64

This method makes possible faster retrieval of the published and unpublished data and an evaluation to be made of the special requests to ascertain time and costs, if any, which will be involved. Including the years 1962-64 in the request (even though the index indicated no available data) makes a search of the records possible to locate data which may be of use. An explanation of the intended use of the data would also be helpful in giving you the best possible service.

DEFINITIONS

VITAL EVENT: Births, deaths, marriages, and dissolutions.

HISTORICAL YEARS: Years data is listed for a specific topic.

DATA:

Resident: The vital event pertains to the place of residence of the person

concerned - the actual place of occurrence is irrelevant.

Live Births: The place of residence for the child is the usual residence of

the mother. Listing is resident unless specified as occurrence.

Deaths: The place of residence is the usual residence of the decedent.

Listing is resident unless specified as occurrence.

Marriages and

Dissolutions: Are listed by place of occurrence.

Occurrence: The vital event pertains to the place of occurrence. The

residence of the person concerned is irrelevant.

POPULATION: Estimated resident population on July 1st.

BIRTHS:

Live Birth: Birth of a child who shows evidence of life after expulsion or

extraction.

Immature: Live birth weight of 2500 grams (5 lbs. 8 ozs.) or less,

regardless of the period of gestation.

Congenital

Malformations: Deformity existing before birth.

Live Birth Injury: Any physical injury to a live newborn infant resulting from the

birth process.

DEATHS:

Underlying Cause: Is the disease or injury which initiated the sequence of morbid

events leading directly to death, or the circumstances of the accident or violence which produced the fatal injury. The responsibility for indicating the underlying cause of death is

that of the certifying physician or medical examiner.

Associated Conditions: Diseases or injuries reported on the death certificate with the

underlying cause.

Fetal: A birth after 20 weeks gestation which is not a live birth.

Infant: Death of a child under one year of age.

Maternal: Death due to complications of pregnancy, labor, delivery, and

puerperium.

Neonatal: Death of an infant occurring less than 28 days following birth.

MARRIAGES:

First: First marriage for only one of the parties.

The first marriage for both the groom and the bride. Primary:

Remainder: Not the first marriage for either party.

Is the mid-point for the range of ages (brides or grooms). Half are younger and half are older than the median age. Median Age:

Includes annulments. DISSOLUTIONS:


Median Age: The same definition of the median age of brides or grooms is
