The Iowa Department of Natural Resources will be hosting a virtual public meeting on Thursday, January 5, 2023, at 1:00 p.m. to gather public comment on the Fawn Hollow Feedlot Nutrient Management Plan (NMP). #### **Consent Orders**

#### Dec. 22 EcoNewsWire

A consent order is issued as an alternative to issuing an administrative order. A consent order indicates that the DNR has voluntarily entered into a legally enforceable agreement with the other party.

### **Dubuque County**

Knuth Farms Pay a \$3,000 administrative penalty.

## **Administrative Orders**

Responsible parties have 60 days to appeal the order or 60 days to pay the penalty.
