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IOWA INDIVIDUAL INCOME TAX SCHOOL DISTRICT REPORT TAX YEAR 2011

This annual report contains the income and tax paid by residents of each school district in the state during 2011. In addition, this document lists school districts imposing the income surtax and the rates applied for tax years 2011 and 2012.

School districts are listed under the county in which the administration offices are located. In analyzing the data in this report, there are several considerations that need to be taken into account.

1. **Estimation of Surtax** – The surtax base is the statutory amount (Iowa Code Chapter 257.21) to which a surtax rate may be applied to estimate the amount of surtax that could be collected by a school district. The surtax base is equal to line 54 of the 2011 IA 1040 or line 11 of the 2011 IA 1040A. The surtax base is not the same as the tax liability reported in the Individual Income Tax Annual Statistical Report. The tax in that report is equal to line 54 of the 2011 IA 1040 less the refundable credits beginning on line 62.

2. **Nonresident Taxation** – Iowa tax law requires that nonresidents and part-year residents report income from Iowa and non-Iowa sources, even though only income from Iowa sources is taxed. Most of the non-Iowa income is reported in the nonresident portion of this report that includes taxpayers who live outside of Iowa and taxpayers who moved out of Iowa during 2011. However, some of it is included in the income measures in the case of taxpayers who moved into a school district during 2011 but also had income from outside the state. Thus, while the surtax base for each district is correct, the income for the district may be somewhat overstated.

3. **2011 Tax Law Revisions** – Revisions affecting the 2011 tax return include such changes as indexation of the standard deduction and taxable income brackets and continued phase-out of the taxation of Social Security benefits. GLOSSARY OF TERMS

Adjusted Gross Income - Income reported on line 26 of the 2011 IA 1040 return or line 4 of the 2011 IA 1040A.

Net Taxable Income - Income subject to tax after adjustment for net federal tax payments and itemized or standard deductions.

Number of Returns - Total number of returns filed; married persons filing separately on a combined return are counted as two returns.

Personal and Dependent Credits - The number of credits claimed in step 3 of the 2011 IA 1040 or 1040A. One personal credit is allowed for the taxpayer, plus one for a spouse on joint returns. One additional personal credit may be claimed by unmarried heads of households, as well as by taxpayers who are age 65 or older or blind. For example, a taxpayer who is blind and age 65 receives three personal credits. One dependent credit is allowed for each qualified dependent in the household.

Surtax Base - The tax base that should be used to estimate the amount of surtax that could be collected in a school district.

- (a) Residents of Appanoose County must add a 1% local option surtax for emergency medical services to the rates that are listed.
- (b) For tax year 2012, Anthon Oto (0270) merged with Maple Valley (4033) to form Maple Valley-Anthon Oto (4033) with a surtax rate of 0% in 2012.
- (c) For tax year 2012, Pomeroy-Palmer (5301) was absorbed by Pocahontas Area (5283) with a surtax rate of 1% in 2012.
- (d) For tax year 2012, Fremont (2367) merged with Eddyville-Blakesburg (0657) to form Eddyville-Blakesburg-Fremont (0657) with a surtax rate of 5% in 2012.
