Preschool Program Partnerships

A <u>recent report</u> using Iowa's Integrated Data System for Decision-Making (I2D2) showed that over half of Iowa Head Start children simultaneously enrolled in Iowa's Statewide Voluntary Preschool Program. Children in Head Start programs with strong partnerships in their school district were 48 times more likely to also be enrolled in the Statewide Voluntary Preschool Program. Previous work demonstrated that children enrolled full-time scored significantly better on academic and social-emotional skills at the end of their preschool year. A new <u>data brief</u> is now available.
