# Animal Food Due Dates Guide

The Commercial Feed and Fertilizer Bureau administers the Iowa Commercial Feed Law. The bureau regulates the manufacturing and the distribution of all Commercial Feed in Iowa. Commercial feed includes pet and specialty pet food, including treats.

---

## Commercial Feed License

- Every Feed License expires on June 30, of odd numbered years
- The system opens renewals June 1<sup>st</sup>, of odd numbered years
- \$20 Fee on company level

---

## Small Package Pet Food

### Label Renewal

- Labels expire annually on December 31<sup>st</sup>
- The system opens renewals December 1<sup>st</sup>
- \$50 Fee per Product

### New Labels

- Can be entered at any time throughout the year prior to selling
- If entered in December it will count towards the following years registration
- \$50 Fee per Product
  - Product based on recipe not size, package weight, or shape

## Feed Tonnage Report and Inspection Fee

### Period 1 January – June

- Opens on June 1<sup>st</sup>
- Last day without late fee August 15<sup>th</sup>
- License goes into Suspended status on August 16<sup>th</sup> until Tonnage is reported and fee paid
- \$0.12 per Ton with \$20 minimum
- Late Fee \$50 or 10% whichever is greater

### Period 2 July – December

- Opens December 1<sup>st</sup>
- Last day without late fee February 15<sup>th</sup>
- License goes into Suspended status on February 16<sup>th</sup> until Tonnage is reported and fee paid
- \$0.12 per Ton with \$20 minimum
- Late Fee \$50 or 10% whichever is greater
