Aggregation Equipment Upgrade

Implementation of the 10Gb converged aggregation network.

- Allows Ethernet and IP services to pass through the network on a redundant and more resilient infrastructure.
- Provides an efficient, diverse network with greater capacity.

State Firewall Decentralization

The second phase includes taking 17 government agencies and providing their own individualized security solution.

- Add capabilities like intrusion prevention, content filtering, anti-malware and more.
- Explore enhanced reporting for agencies.

Cloud Services

Continue to expand connectivity for customers to reach cloud services by using our direct express routes to Microsoft (Azure), Amazon (AWS), Google Cloud, and 250+ additional cloud providers.


