INTRODUCTION

This reference booklet has been prepared to provide State Employment Service personnel and other interested persons with information about the different occupational licenses or certificates issued by various Boards, Commissions, and Departments of Iowa. The bulk of the information was extracted from the Code of Iowa and reviewed by the various licensing authorities. This booklet represents the only single source of readily accessible occupational licensing information in the State.

Occupations contained herein are those that the State of Iowa will allow an individual to engage in only when established licensing requirements have been met. Not included are dealer or business licenses such as Retail Sales Permits, Cigarette Sales Permits, Automobile Dealer Licenses, etc. Also not included are occupational licenses issued by Federal Agencies such as Pilot's Licenses and Radio Operator's Licenses; nor occupational licenses issued by sub-divisions of the State such as Building Inspector's Licenses, Plumber's Licenses and Stationary Engineer's Licenses. Another category of occupational licenses not included are those licenses issued by organizations other than the State--such as Registered Laboratory Technicians and Certified Life Underwriters, etc.

Information given for each occupation includes: age, education, and experience requirements; if an examination is required, where and when it is given; whether or not reciprocity can be established between other states; renewal procedures; fees; the term of the license; where to get additional information; and the Dictionary of Occupational Titles' occupational code and title.

Even though we have attempted to make the information as reliable as possible, it cannot be considered as completely authoritative and is subject to change at any time. Therefore, we will review this publication periodically, and attempt to keep the information as current as possible.

We would like to extend our thanks to the various licensing authorities, to whom we are deeply indebted for their cooperation in preparing this booklet.

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ARCHITECT

AGE, EDUCATION AND EXPERIENCE REQUIREMENTS

At least 21 years of age, graduation from an accredited school of architecture or the equivalents thereof plus at least three years of practical experience under a registered architect.

EXAMINATION

Standard NCARB written examinations are given twice each year in Des Moines, Iowa in June and December.

Standard NCARB senior examinations are given upon application and appearance before the Board during a regular meeting.

IF FROM OUT OF STATE

Architect licensed in other states may be issued licenses in Iowa if the other state's licensing requirements are equal to or higher than Iowa's.

RENEWAL PROCEDURE

Licenses are renewed by application following notification by the board and paying the renewal fee.

BARBER

AGE, EDUCATION AND EXPERIENCE REQUIREMENTS

All applicants must have completed 18 months as an apprentice barber working for a licensed barber.

EXAMINATION

There are written, oral, and practical exams given four times a year at the Capitol Building in Des Moines, Iowa.

IF FROM OUT OF STATE

A person who has practiced barbering in another state for more than five years may be permitted to take the barbering exam for a license to practice in Iowa.

RENEWAL PROCEDURE

Licenses are renewed by application to the Board accompanied with the renewal fee.

BARBER SCHOOL ASSISTANT INSTRUCTOR

INSTRUCTOR, VOCATIONAL TRAINING

AGE, EDUCATION AND EXPERIENCE REQUIREMENTS

Applicants must have completed high school or an equivalent and be a graduate of an approved school of barbering and the holder of an Iowa barber license.

EXAMINATION

There is no examination to receive this temporary license. However, the Assistant Instructor must after 6 months make application for an instructor's license. If the Assistant Instructor fails the exam for the instructor's license, the temporary license is extended till the next regularly scheduled examination; at which time the assistant must pass the exam or discontinue all connections with the school.

IF FROM OUT OF STATE

There is no provision in the Iowa law for an out of state applicant to receive their assistant's license other than through the same channels as applicants from Iowa.

RENEWAL PROCEDURE

There are no renewals except as provided under "Examination" above.

INSTRUCTOR, VOCATIONAL TRAINING

AGE, EDUCATION AND EXPERIENCE REQUIREMENTS

Applicants must be high school graduates or the equivalent thereof, and be the holder of an Iowa license to practice barbering for either a five-year period immediately preceding the time of application; or have six months experience as an Assistant Instructor immediately preceding the time of application.

EXAMINATION

There is an examination given every three months at the Capitol Building in Des Moines, Iowa

IF FROM OUT OF STATE

A license may be issued to licensed instructors or managers in other states if the other state has qualifying laws equal to or higher than Iowa's. Examination required.

RENEWAL PROCEDURE

Licenses are renewed annually by application to the licensing board, accompanied by the renewal fee.

BUS DRIVER

AGE, EDUCATION AND EXPERIENCE REQUIREMENTS

The minimum age to qualify for a Chauffeur's license to drive a passenger bus other than a school bus is 21. An I.C.C. physical examination must also be passed annually. The minimum qualifying age to drive a school bus is 16 if the applicant has passed an approved course in driver's education. If not, the minimum age is 18. No I.C.C. physical is required for school bus drivers.

EXAMINATION

Applicants must pass a written, an eye examination and a driving test. These tests are given at any County Driver's License Examining station which is open at least once per week.

IF FROM OUT OF STATE

There are no reciprocity provisions as such; however, the driving test is generally waived for new residents of Iowa who have a valid license allowing them to drive a bus issued by the state from which they came. There is no need for a non-resident to have an Iowa license; since a person properly licensed in the state in which he resides may drive anywhere. The exception is a person who accepts employment as a chauffeur, from an Iowa Resident, in which case he must have an Iowa Chauffeur's License.

RENEWAL PROCEDURE

Licenses are renewed by passing an eye examination and paying the renewal fee.

CERTIFIED PUBLIC ACCOUNTANT

ACCOUNTANT

AGE, EDUCATION AND EXPERIENCE REQUIREMENTS

To qualify to take the C.P.A. examination applicant must be a college senior in his final semester, majoring in accounting, or a college graduate with a major in accounting, or three years qualifying public accounting experience.

To receive the C.P.A. certificate applicant must be a college graduate with a major in accounting, with one year's experience. All others must have three years of qualifying experience. They must also be United States citizens and at least 21 years old.

EXAMINATION

There is a written examination given twice a year in May and November. The places the exams will be given are announced 60 days prior to the date of the exams.

IF FROM OUT OF STATE

A person licensed in another state may be issued a license in Iowa without further testing if the other state's licensing requirements are equal to or higher than Iowa's.

RENEWAL PROCEDURE

Licenses are renewed by application to the Board, accompanied by the renewal fee.

CHIROPRACTOR

AGE, EDUCATION AND EXPERIENCE REQUIREMENTS

Applicants must be high school graduates and graduates of an approved school of chiropractic. He or she must have an Iowa Basic Science Certificate.

EXAMINATION

Written examinations are given the first Monday, Tuesday and Wednesday of April, August and December at the Palmer College of Chiropractic, Davenport, Iowa. Practical examinations are also given.

IF FROM OUT OF STATE

A license may be issued to anyone who has been licensed in another state; providing the licensing requirements there are equal to or higher than Iowa's. Must have an Iowa Basic Science Certificate and appear before the board.

RENEWAL PROCEDURE

Every license shall expire on the 30th day of June. Application for renewal shall be made in writing to the Department of Health, accompanied by the fee thirty days prior to expiration date.

AGE, EDUCATION AND EXPERIENCE REQUIREMENTS

Applicants must complete a 2100 hour course at an approved school of cosmetology and be at least 18 years old.

EXAMINATION

There is a practical demonstration and a written examination given to applicants at the Veterans Auditorium in Des Moines, Iowa, four times per year.

IF FROM OUT OF STATE

A license may be issued to anyone who has been licensed in another state providing the licensing requirements are equal to or higher than Iowa's.

RENEWAL PROCEDURE

Licenses are renewed by sending a written application for renewal, accompanied by the renewal fee to the Department of Health.

AGE, EDUCATION AND EXPERIENCE REQUIREMENTS

Applicants must have a license to practice cosmetology issued by the Iowa State Department of Health and have completed a course for instructors at an approved school of cosmetology. They must also be 21 years old. One year of experience in private practice may be substituted for the advanced training.

EXAMINATION

There is a practical demonstration and a written examination required of each applicant. These are given four times per year at the Veterans Auditorium in Des Moines, Iowa.

IF FROM OUT OF STATE

A license may be issued to anyone who has been licensed in another state providing the licensing requirements are equal to or higher than Iowa's.

RENEWAL PROCEDURE

Licenses are renewed by sending a written application for renewal, accompanied by the renewal fee, to the Department of Health.

DENTAL HYGIENIST

AGE, EDUCATION AND EXPERIENCE REQUIREMENTS

All applicants must be a graduate of an accredited high school in this state, or a school of like and equal standing in any other state or country, or has in earned units of study the equivalent necessary for graduation, and has earned a diploma or certificate from an accredited school of dental hygiene.

EXAMINATION

There is a written examination given at the Dental School in Iowa City, Iowa, once a year. A practical demonstration is also required.

IF FROM OUT OF STATE

Licenses may be issued to applicants licensed in other states; providing the other states requirements are equal to or higher than Iowa's.

RENEWAL PROCEDURE

All licenses expire on June 30th. Application for renewal of the license must be made in writing to the Department at least sixty days prior to this expiration date, accompanied by the legal fee.

DENTIST

AGE, EDUCATION AND EXPERIENCE REQUIREMENTS

All applicants must be graduates of a dental college approved by the Board of Denistry.

EXAMINATION

There is a written examination and a practical demonstration of competence. These are given at the Dental College in Iowa City, Iowa, each spring.

IF FROM OUT OF STATE

Licenses may be issued to applicants licensed in other states; providing the other state's requirements are equal to or higher than Iowa's.

RENEWAL PROCEDURE

All licenses expire on June 30th. Applications for renewal of the license must be made in writing to the department at least sixty days prior to this expiration date accompanied by the legal fee.

Applicants must be 21 years old and a citizen of the United States. They cannot have been convicted of a felony.

EXAMINATION

There is a written examination given three times a year by appointment at the State Office Building in Des Moines, Iowa.

IF FROM OUT OF STATE

A person from out of state may receive an Iowa license in the same manner as an Iowa resident. Being an Iowa resident is not a requirement.

RENEWAL PROCEDURE

The license is automatically renewed by paying the renewal fee and renewing the required bond.

AGE, EDUCATION AND EXPERIENCE REQUIREMENTS

Applicants must have completed two years of pre-mortuary training in an approved college, junior college or university followed by one academic year of mortuary school and one year of apprenticeship.

EXAMINATION

Applicants must pass written, oral and practical exams given at the Lucas State Office Building in Des Moines, Iowa, twice a year.

IF FROM OUT OF STATE

Embalmers licensed in another state may be issued a license in Iowa if the other state's licensing requirements are equal to or higher than Iowa's.

RENEWAL PROCEDURE

Every license shall expire on the 30th day of June. Applications for renewal shall be made in writing to the Department of Health, accompanied by the legal fee, at least thirty days prior to the expiration of such license.

Applicants must have completed two years of pre-mortuary training in an approved college, junior college, or university followed by one academic year of mortuary school and one year of apprenticeship.

EXAMINATION

There is a written and an oral exam given at the State Office Building in Des Moines, Iowa, twice a year.

IF FROM OUT OF STATE

There are no provisions for reciprocity in this occupation; however, there are such provisions for Embalmers.

RENEWAL PROCEDURE

Every license shall expire on the 30th day of June. Applications for renewal shall be made in writing to the Department of Health, accompanied by the legal fee, at least 30 days prior to the expiration of such license.

The applicant shall hold a master's degree granted by an institution approved by the State Board of Public Instruction with specialization in a field of instruction offered in the arts and sciences division of an area community college. This preparation shall include six semester hours of professional preparation appropriate for college teaching, provided that adequate experience in college teaching as evaluated by a review committee appointed by the State Superintendent of Public Instruction shall be accepted in lieu of part or all the required credits in professional education.

EXAMINATION

Certificates may be issued to applicants who are certified in other states if the other state's requirements are equal to or higher than Iowa's.

AGE, EDUCATION AND EXPERIENCE REQUIREMENTS

Each vocational and technical curriculum has different educational and experience qualifications for its instructors. Although these qualifications vary considerably; the requirements are spelled out in a book called "State Plan for Vocational Education" published by the State Department of Public Instruction. After a qualified person has been selected by the Local Board of Education for a position, Iowa State Department of Public Instruction is requested to issue the certificate.

EXAMINATION

None.

IF FROM OUT OF STATE

A person from out of state may receive an Iowa certificate in the same manner as an Iowa resident. Being an Iowa resident is not a qualification.

RENEWAL PROCEDURE

Certificates are renewed by written application to the State Department of Public Instruction, accompanied with the renewal fee.

INSURANCE SALESMAN

AGE, EDUCATION AND EXPERIENCE REQUIREMENTS

Individual consideration given to any applicant over age 18.

EXAMINATION

There is a written exam for applicants not previously qualified in Iowa. Iowa residents need not take the exam if they qualify under the Grandfather Clause. The exam is given in the Grimes State Office Building, Des Moines, Iowa, every Wednesday. Applicant must be registered in advance and sponsored by an Insurance Company.

IF FROM OUT OF STATE

Exams are waived for applicants from states having qualifying laws. Fee is \$5.00 for each line.

RENEWAL PROCEDURE

Licenses are renewed automatically. The Insurance Department of Iowa sends the renewed licenses of all salesmen of an insurance company to the company with a bill covering all renewals. Fees are retaliatory according to the fees charged Iowa companies by home state company.

Licenses may be issued to Lawyers who have practiced law at least five years in another state.

IF FROM OUT OF STATE

There are no provisions in the Iowa law for Licensed Milk Graders in other states to be issued a license in Iowa other than through the same channels an Iowa resident would follow.

RENEWAL PROCEDURE

Licenses expire each July 1st and the licensee must apply for renewal, following notification by the Department.

A practical examination is given to determine if the applicant is competent to test cream and milk for butterfat content using the Babcock Test. There is a written test also.

IF FROM OUT OF STATE

There are no provisions in the Iowa law for licensed Milk Testers in other states to be issued a license in Iowa, other than through the same channels an Iowa resident would follow.

IF FROM OUT OF STATE

A license may be issued to an applicant who has been licensed in another state without further testing if the applicant met the requirements in effect in Iowa at the time of original licensure.

RENEWAL PROCEDURE

All licenses expire on June 30th. Applications for renewal must be made in writing to the Department of Health at least thirty days prior to expiration. Accompanying the application must be the renewal fee and proof satisfactory to the department that the licensee has attended an educational clinic held by the Iowa Optometric Association or an equivalent.

OSTEOPATHIC PHYSICIAN AND SURGEON

AGE, EDUCATION AND EXPERIENCE REQUIREMENTS

Applicant must be 21 years of age and of good moral character. Applicants must be graduates of an approved college of Osteopathic Medicine and Surgery or an equivalent thereof, and have completed a one year internship at an approved hospital. A licensed Osteopathic Physician may be issued a license to practice osteopathic medicine and surgery by completing a two year post graduate program at an accredited college of osteopathic medicine and surgery and pass an examination on the subject of surgery. Applicant must obtain Iowa Basic Science Certificate, be a citizen of the United States or declare intention to become a citizen of the United States.

EXAMINATION

There is an examination given in January in Des Moines and in June at Iowa City; however, the time and place of the examination is announced in such a manner as may be deemed expedient and in ample time to allow all candidates to comply.

IF FROM OUT OF STATE

A license may be issued to anyone who has been licensed in another state, providing the licensing requirements are equal to those in Iowa. The fee is \$100.00

RENEWAL PROCEDURE

Application for renewal must be made annually to the Board of Medical Examiners. The renewal fee must accompany the application.

Applicants must be graduates of an approved college of osteopathic medicine and surgery and have completed a one-year internship at an approved hospital. Applicant need not have basic science certificate.

EXAMINATION

Applicants must have completed a one-year course at an approved Watchmaking School plus one year of experience or completed three years of apprenticeship to an Iowa Licensed Watchmaker to qualify to take the examination. Applicants must be at least nineteen years of age.

Any person who has served as a watchmaker in another state for three years or more, shall be permitted to take the examination required. Such showing of service in another state shall be supported by proper affidavits from responsible persons in said other state.

EXAMINATION

There is a written examination and a demonstration of competence that must be completed. This is given two or three times a year in Des Moines, Iowa. The examination requires two days of time.

IF FROM OUT OF STATE

A license may be issued to a person who was licensed in another state without further testing if the Watchmaker passed a state examination for his license or if the Watchmaker was in the business of watchmaking during the 5 year period immediately preceding the time of application.

RENEWAL PROCEDURE

Licenses expire each June 31st, and an application for renewal accompanied by the renewal fee must be mailed to the office of the Board before June 1st.

AGE, EDUCATION AND EXPERIENCE REQUIREMENTS

Varies with the four classifications of wastewater treatment plants according to the population of the area served and methods of treatment utilized. (Four classifications of water treatment plants and three classifications of water distribution systems. Certain certification requirements apply equally to all classes.

Sample education and experience requirements are:

Class I	2 years high school or equivalent plus 1 year's experience
Class II	High school education or equivalent plus 1 year's experience
Class III	High school plus four years experience
Class IV	Bachelors Degree in engineering plus two year's experience

EXAMINATION

Written examination given at various times and locations throughout the state. Contact certification board for details of times and locations.

IF FROM OUT OF STATE

The Board of Certification may recommend to the Commissioner certification without examination of an applicant certified by another state; providing that the applicant has passed an examination equivalent to Iowa's and has met the pertinent education and experience requirements.

RENEWAL PROCEDURE

Must be renewed annually by submitting application for renewal, plus the required fees.
