



APPENDIX:

Populations of Iowa Cities and Towns Responding to the License and Premit Fee Survey



I. INTRODUCTION

This manual has been prepared as an aid to those cities and towns desiring to review their license and permit fee schedules. The body of the booklet consists of a survey of those fees charged by 97 Iowa cities and 31 randomly selected Iowa towns.

When reviewing the schedule of fees, it will be of particular interest to note the rate and manner of charge used by cities or towns with a population similar to your city or town. Cities and towns have therefore been arranged in four basic groupings according to their population:

1. Cities over 15,000

pro?

- 2. Cities between 2,000 and 15,000
- 3. Towns between 500 and 2,000
- 4. Towns of less than 500

<u>Appendix 1</u> lists those cities and towns participating in the survey in order of population and will serve as an easy source of reference for population classification.

When referring to a particular schedule of fees (e.g. dog licenses), please keep in mind that every city or town did not furnish information regarding that schedule; therefore, the fact that a city or town is not listed under that schedule does not mean that they do not have a fee.

An excellent and comprehensive discussion of the concept and administration of a license and permit system has been prepared by the Institute of Public Affairs of the University of Iowa. This booklet, entitled <u>Guide For Clerks</u>, #13 is available from the Institute of Public Affairs at the University of Iowa or from the League of Iowa Municipalities. A brief summary of the prominent features regarding licenses and permits as explained in the <u>Guide for Clerks</u> will be presented in the following several paragraphs. It will be necessary, however, to consult the <u>Guide</u> for a more complete and thorough discussion of license and permit fees.

In legal terminology a "license" is defined as a temporary non-assignable personal privilege granted under the police power for regulation in the interest of public health, safety, morals and welfare by some competent governmental authority, often revocable at the will of the licensor, to do some particular act or to engage in some activity of a continuing nature which could not be done lawfully without such a license. A "permit" is an authorization by a competent governmental authority of an act or activity that will be completed, the permit thereby being executed or terminated. A permit authorizes the grantee to do some act not forbidden by law, but not allowable without such authority.

The Iowa law, however, seems to make no clear-cut distinction between licenses and permits; sometimes the terms are used interchangeably. For a complete list of those occupations and activities which municipalities can legally regulate and license, refer to the pertinent sections of the <u>Code of</u> <u>Iowa</u> as designated by the <u>Guide for Clerks #13</u>.

In both legal and practical terms it is wise to have an ordinance for a license or permit rather than to establish them by administrative order or some other authority. The <u>Iowa Model</u> <u>Ordinances</u> series prepared by the Institute of Public Affairs in cooperation with the League of Iowa Municipalities is an excellent source of information on ordinances relating to licenses and permits.

There should be an application form for each license and permit. This application form can be standard and apply to most types of licenses and permits. If the form is not dated, it may be used year after year and thereby save the expense of annual reprinting. The license or permit should be issued as a printed document bearing the official seal of the city or town.

The city clerk is usually responsible for (1) receiving applications, (2) examining the applications or applicants as to their compliance with the required qualifications, (3) issuing the license(in some cities the license must first be approved by the city council), and (4) collecting and accounting for the required license fees. It has been found that licenses are more likely to be paid on time if a penalty or fine is levied against those persons who have not paid their license by the required date.
