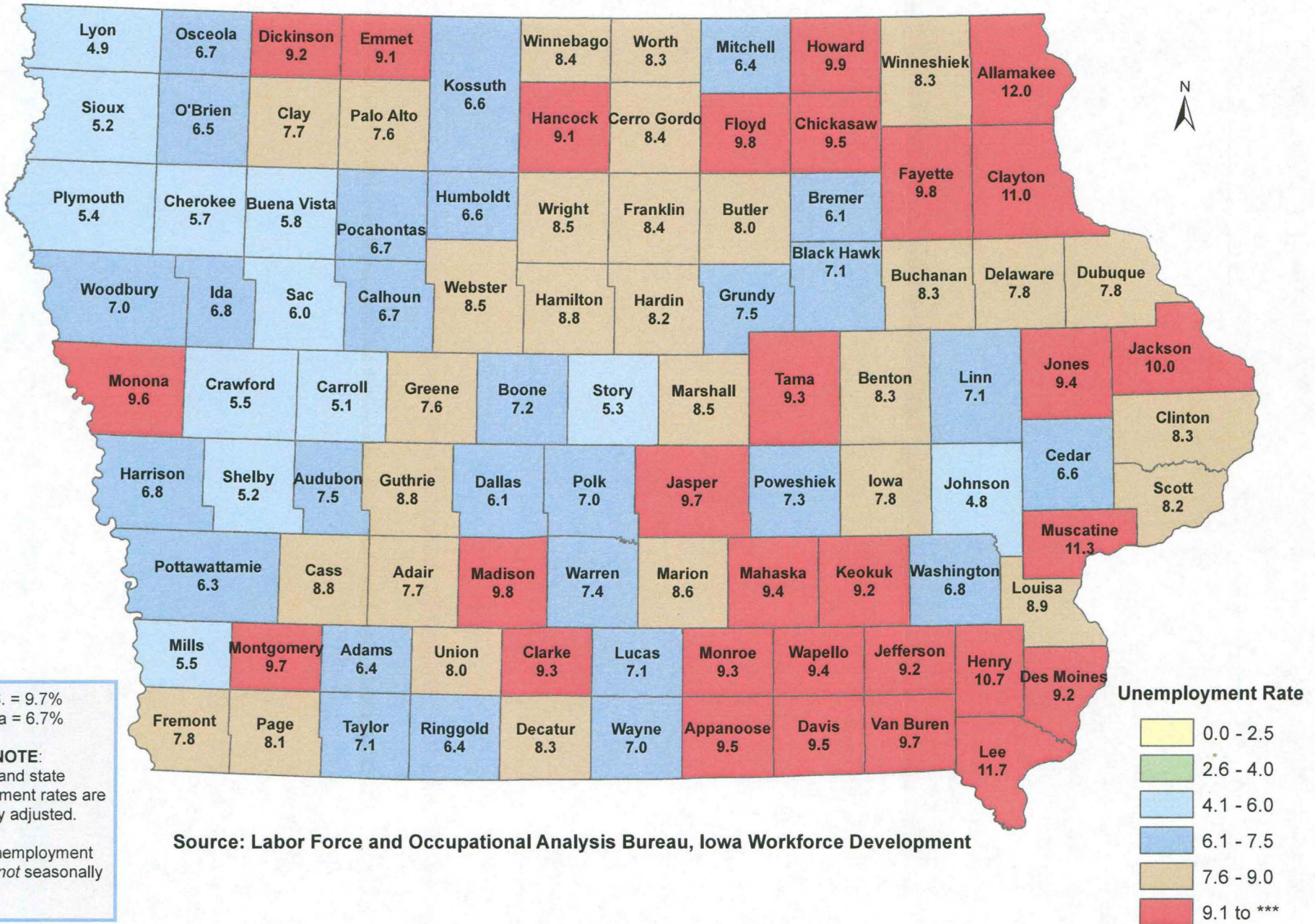

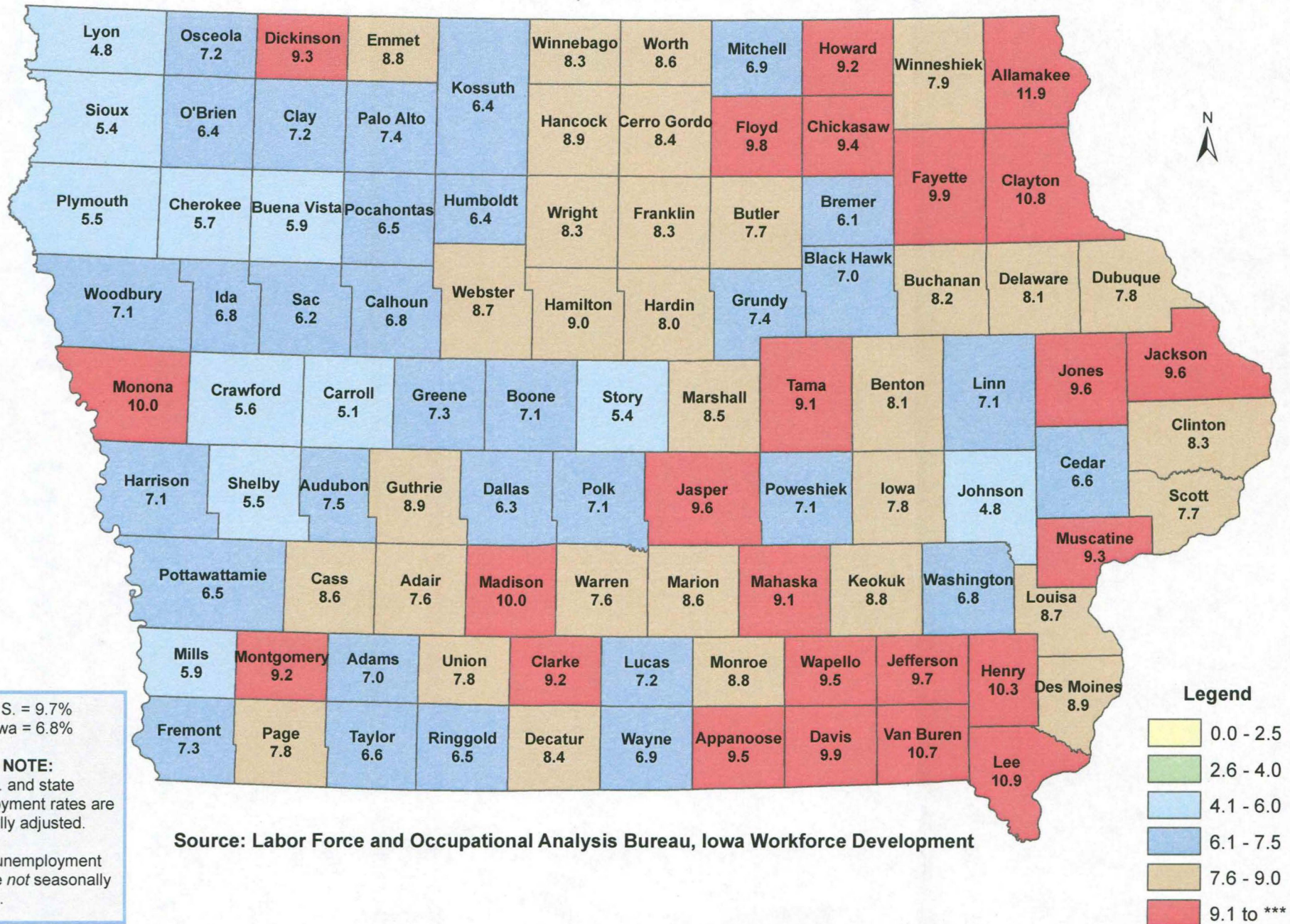

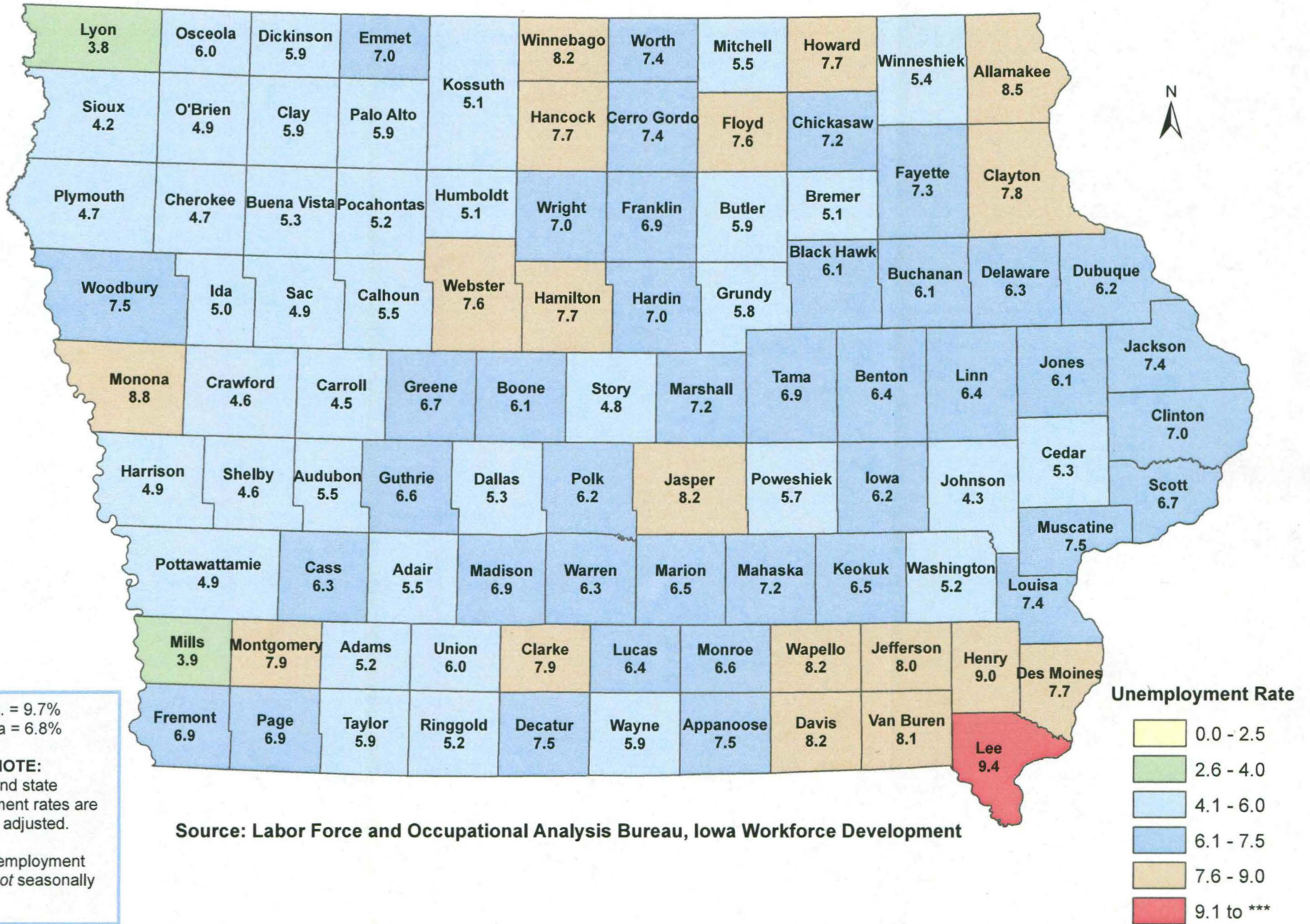

May 2010

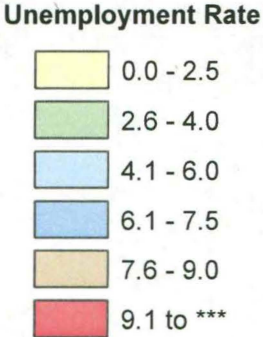

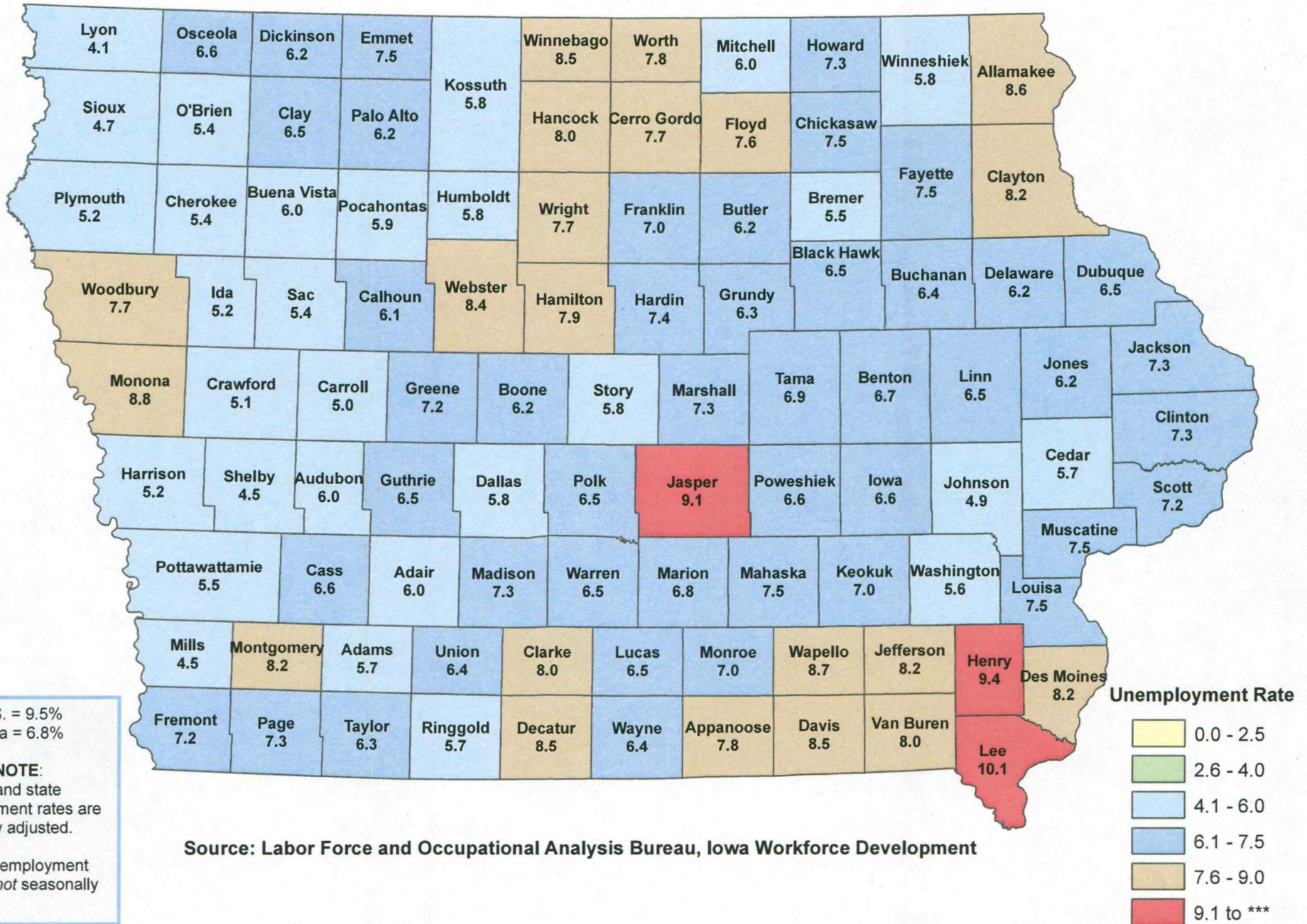

June 2010

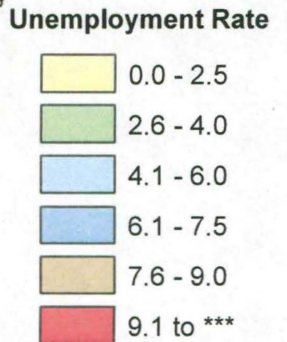

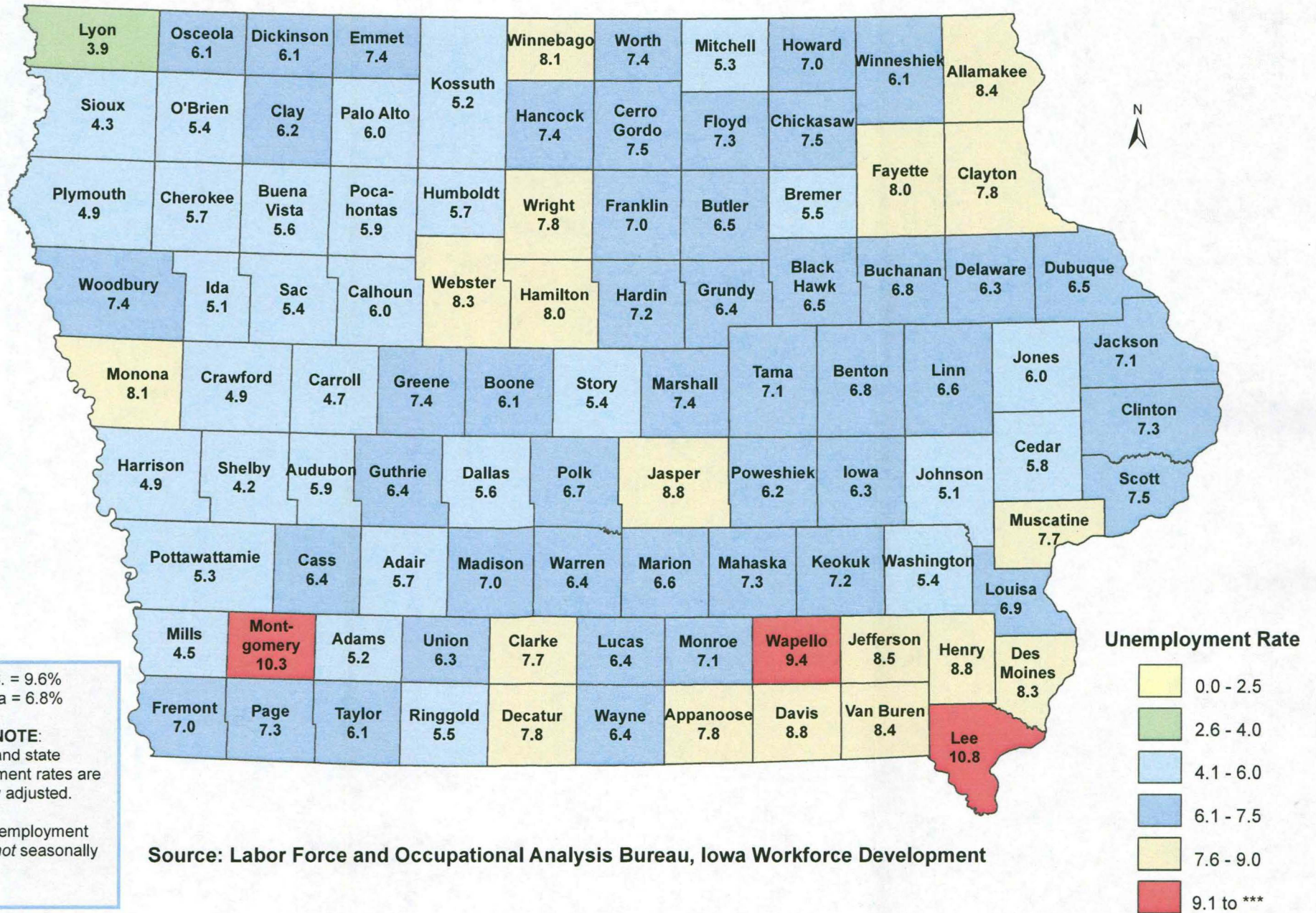

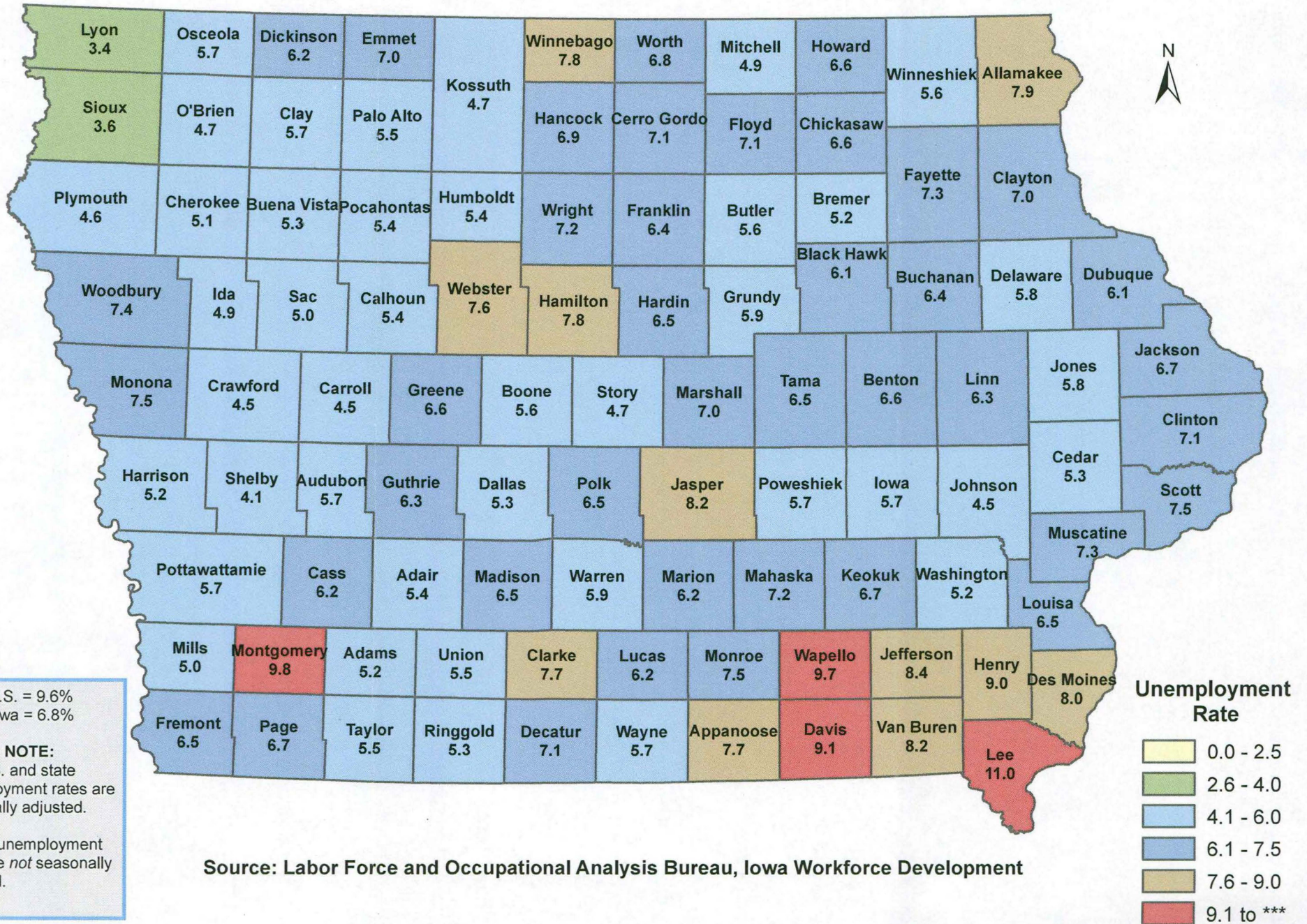

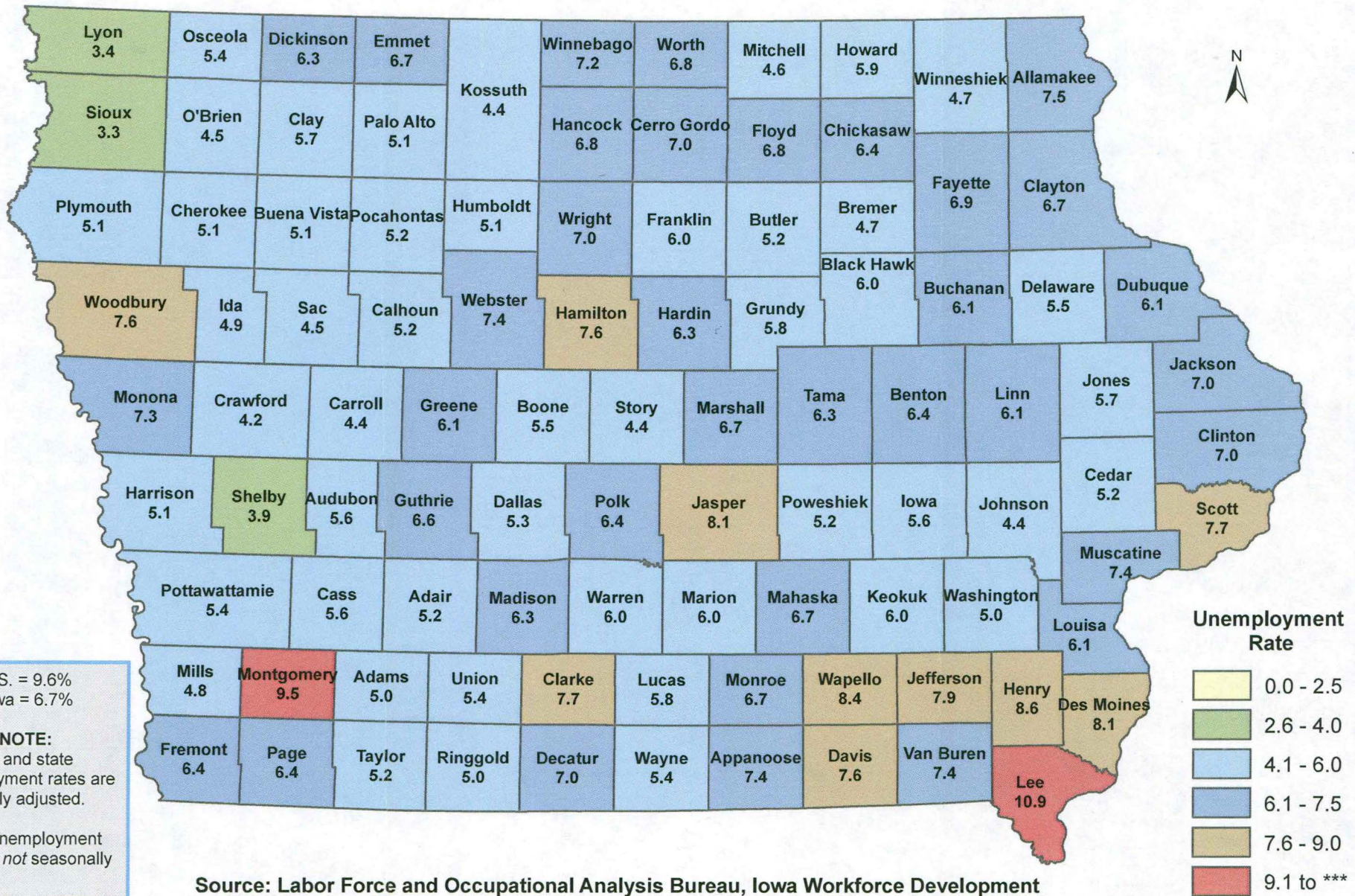

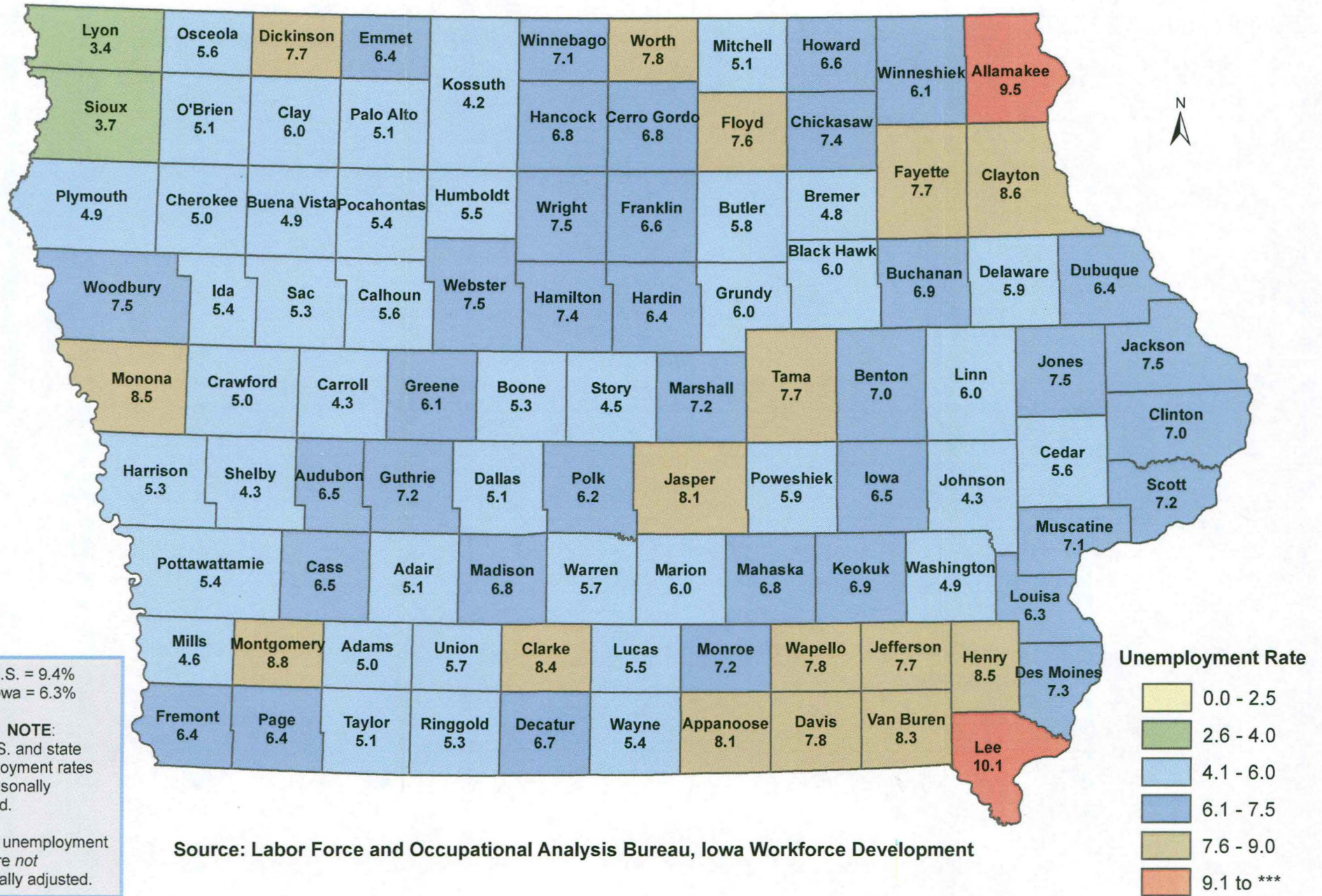

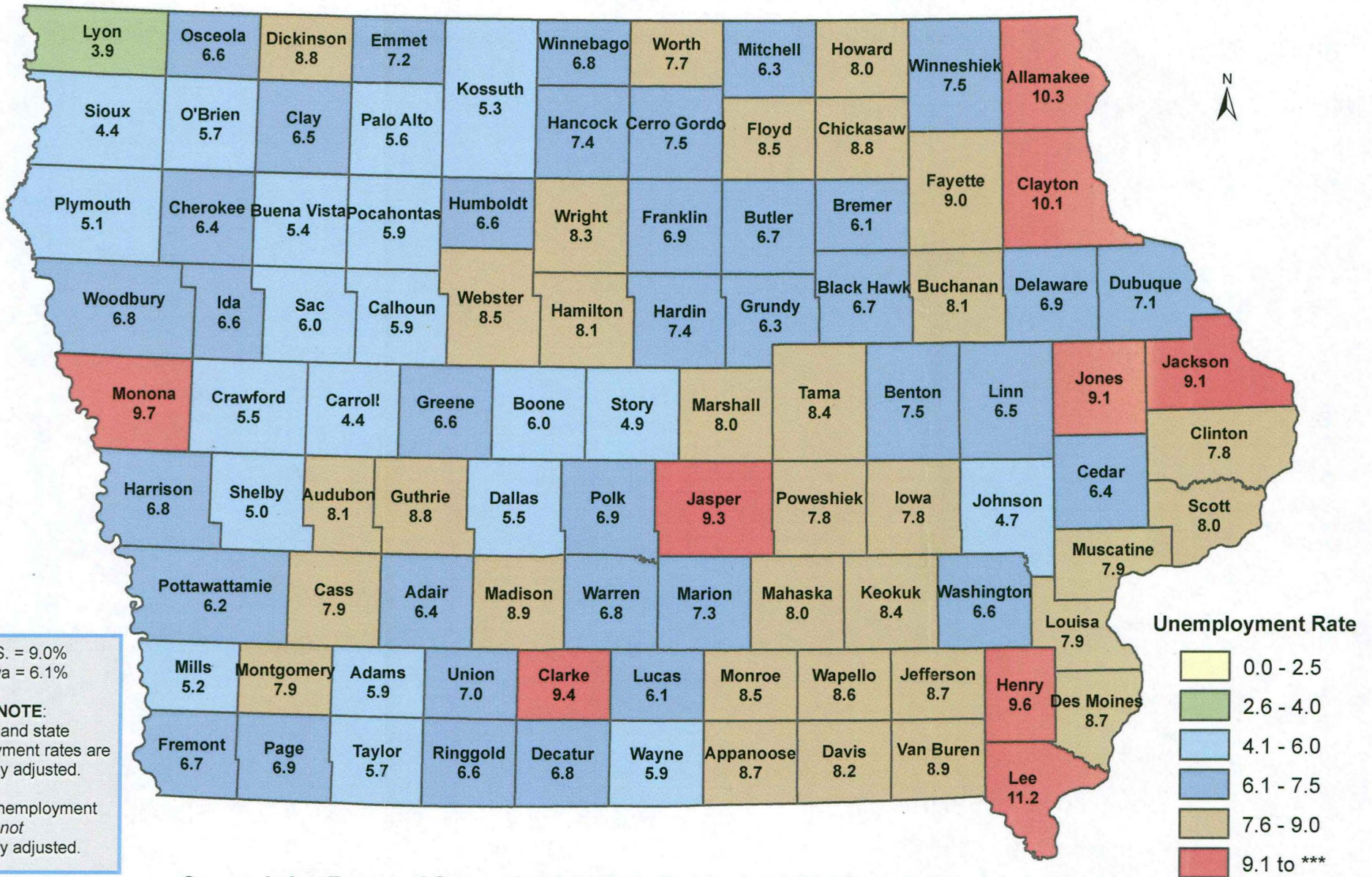
