INDUSTRIAL DEVELOPMENT SUMMARY

Industrial development announcements for the state of Iowa during 1980 show an underlying effect of the economic recession. Iowa Development Commission research shows 87 new industrial locations, 144 expansions, 5,844 new jobs created and \$644,893,500 in capital investment.

Prospect activity declined from 93 in 1979 to 64 in 1980, a 31 percent decrease.

New industrial locations are down 13 percent from 1979 and up 11 percent from the ten-year average. Expansions are down 18 percent from 1979 and down 13 percent from the ten-year average. However, when comparing these figures, one must keep in mind that 1979 was a very good year and the tenyear average includes all-time record highs for industrial development in Iowa.

Total new manufacturing job announcements were down 48 percent from 1979 and down 48 percent from the ten-year average.

Capital investment is down 16 percent from 1979, but shows an increase of 57 percent over the ten-year average. Inflation during the past ten years would account for part of the increase in the ten-year average figure.

The source of industrial prospects for Iowa continue to come from companies based in the Midwest. The following standard industrial classifications were the "leaders" during 1980: <u>motor freight transportation and warehousing</u>; <u>food and kindred products</u>; <u>machinery</u>, <u>except electrical</u>; and <u>chemicals and</u> allied products.






