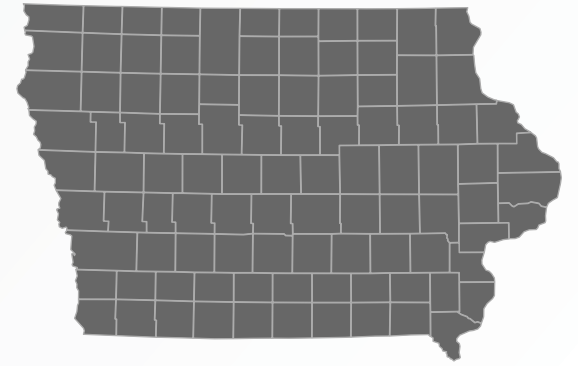

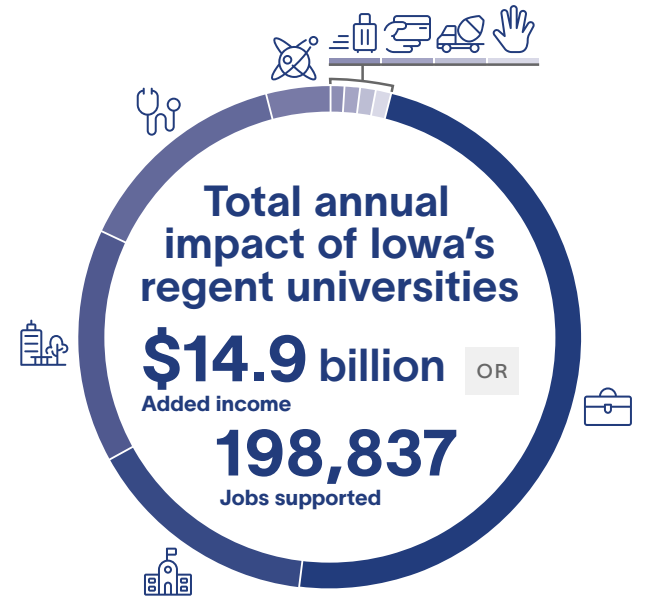

Investment analysis



For every \$1...



Students gain **\$5.40** in lifetime earnings



Taxpayers gain **\$2.70** in added tax revenue and public sector savings



Society gains **\$4.40** in added income and social savings



The average bachelor's degree graduate from Iowa's regent universities will see an increase in earnings of **\$23,200** each year compared to someone with a high school diploma working in Iowa.
