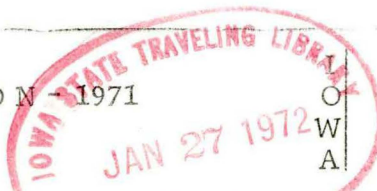

VALUE OF CROP PRODUCTION - 1971

IOWA: Value of farm crops produced on Iowa farms in 1971 totaled 1.94 billion dollars, according to the Iowa Crop and Livestock Reporting Service. This is 8 percent more than the 1970 production, valued at 1.80 billion. Iowa's record billion bushel corn crop accounted for most of the increase over 1970.

Iowa ranked third in value of crop production in 1971. California was the leading State with 2.57 billion dollars, followed by Illinois with 2.02 billion. Texas ranked fourth with 1.37 billion dollars.

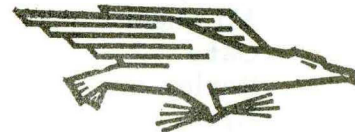
Four crops, corn, soybeans, hay, and oats accounted for 99 percent of the value of all crops produced in Iowa during the past season. Corn accounted for about 63 percent, soybeans 26 percent, all hay 7 percent, and oats 3 percent.

IOWA: Value of farm crops produced on Iowa farms in 1972 totaled 2.45 billion dollars, according to the Iowa Crop and Livestock Reporting Service. This is 23 percent more than the 1971 production, valued at 1.99 billion. Iowa's record corn and soybean crops accounted for most of the increase over 1971.

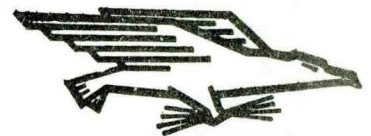
Four crops, corn, soybeans, hay, and oats accounted for 99 percent of the value of all crops produced in Iowa during the past season. Corn accounted for 60 percent, soybeans 32 percent, all hay 6 percent, and oats 2 percent.

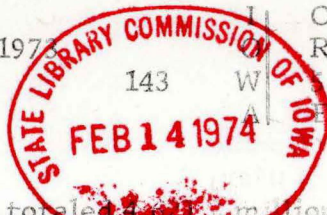

IOWA: Value of Iowa farm crops produced in 1973 totaled 4,621.2 million dollars, the leading State in the Nation, according to the Iowa Crop and Livestock Reporting Service. This is 41 percent more than the value of 1972 crops at 3,275.1 million dollars. An increase in average price for all commodities in 1973 over 1972 and a record soybean crop accounted for the all crop value increase. Corn accounted for 61 percent of the total value, soybeans 33 percent, hay 4 percent and oats 1 percent, or 99 percent of the total crop produced in 1973.

California was the second leading State with a 4,492.7 million dollar crop value and Illinois third with 4,396.9 million.
