This Data has been reviewed to assess and improve the effectiveness of the Department's sexual abuse prevention, detection, and response policies, practices, and training.

Identification of problem areas— The numbers of PREA reports in Second District continued a downward trend in 2016. Only one case was reported in the district. Upon investigation the case was determined to be unfounded. B. Any corrective action taken for each facility and the Department as a whole— There were no substantiated cases in 2016 to review for corrective action.

C. Comparison of current data to data collected in previous years – Number of total cases reported decreased from 14 in CY 14 to 7 in CY15 to 1 in CY16. The only reported case in 2016 was unfounded.

D. An assessment of the Department's progress in addressing sexual abuse - The PREA Audit Cycle was completed in 2016 with the Curt Forbes Residential Facility in Ames successfully completing their initial audit. Staff training and education and offender education efforts have now been well established since PREA was instituted in 2013. Staff is trained in PREA annually. Data suggests that our attention to annual refresher training helps staff educate residents and raises awareness in the area of sexual safety in our facilities.
