- 2. This Data has been reviewed to assess and improve the effectiveness of the Department's sexual abuse prevention, detection, and response policies, practices, and training.
- A. Identification of problem areas Most PREA reports in 2017 were incidents of precursor behavior between clients in a residential facility. The substantiated cases were both precursor behavior of male clients directed towards female clients. Two reports of staff misconduct were reported. Both were investigated and were unfounded.
- B. Any corrective action taken for each facility and the Department as a whole Staff in residential facilities were asked to continue efforts to limit interaction between male and female residents in facilities.
- C. Comparison of current data to data collected in previous years Incidents dropped in CY16 to 1 from a high of 14 in CY14, the first year data was tracked. In CY15 7 incidents were reported. The CY17 numbers have returned to a similar level as CY15.
- D. An assessment of the Department's progress in addressing sexual abuse Facilities in Mason City and Fort Dodge were audited in 2017. Policies, procedures and staff and client knowledge in the area of sexual safety in those facilities met PREA standards.
