Farmers' Market Promotion Program Request Total \$20 Million -Iowa Markets Submit 17 Requests

USDAs Agricultural Marketing Service (AMS) reports that it received 369 applications for its first round of grant disbursement under the Farmers Market Promotion Program (FMPP) with \$19.9 million in total requests, far exceeding the program's FY 2006 appropriation of \$1

million. Proposals were received from 48 states.

States submitting 10 proposals or more included: California 30; New York 21, **IOWA** and Ohio **17** each; Wisconsin 16, Pennsylvania 14; North Carolina, Michigan and Indiana 13 each; Illinois

12; and Colorado, Virginia and Oregon 10 each. These 13 states alone accounted for more than 53% of all proposals submitted.

As of this printing no word as to who has received funding, but we'll keep you posted!
