

# Iowa School Fire Safety Education Program

## Contest Rules and Summary Sheet

### Directions for State Inspection Contest

1. Discuss *Fire Safety Is My Job* brochure and *Operation EDITH* with students.
2. Instruct students to take *Fire Safety Is My Job* and *Operation EDITH* home and discuss them with their parents and neighbors.
3. Parents and students sign their names on pamphlet if they discussed the pamphlet. If *Operation EDITH* was practiced, check number 12 on your fire safety activity list (Pm-1253). Students return pamphlets to teacher.
4. Teacher counts the number of pamphlets returned that have both student and parent signatures.
5. Teacher counts the number of students and parents who practiced *Operation EDITH* (number 12 on activity list, Pm-1253).
6. Teacher completes the Inspection Contest Summary form on back of this sheet and returns it to:

7. Teacher returns pamphlets to students.
8. Deadline for entry is December 20.

### Directions for State Poster Contest

1. Guidelines for posters
  - a. Posters shall be drawn by students under the supervision of their respective teachers.
  - b. Poster must be student's individual work.
  - c. Poster shall measure 12 by 18 inches.
  - d. Poster may be any color and drawn vertically or horizontally. No paste-ons are permitted.
  - e. Poster must contain fire safety message or slogan.
  - f. The following must be printed on the back of each poster submitted:
    - Student's name and grade;
    - School name and address;
    - Local fire department name; and
    - Teacher's name.
2. Submit only one poster from each fourth, fifth, and sixth grade classroom.
3. Send posters to Fire Service Education, Fire Service Building, Iowa State University, Ames, Iowa 50011.
4. Poster judging will take into consideration the following:
  - Appeal—The way in which the poster conveys the message of fire safety by the student making the poster (75 percent); and
  - Artistic ability, originality, neatness (25 percent).
5. Prize winning posters become the property of the Iowa Farm Safety Council.
6. Failure to follow the above guidelines shall be sufficient reason to disqualify a poster from any judging.
7. Deadline for entry is December 20.
