The current era of change began perceptibly in 1985. During the 1984-85 school year there were 438 school districts, and only one of them did not operate a high school within its boundaries. The Corwith-Wesley and Lu Verne districts had been engaged in major sharing since 1980-81 when they began educating all of their high school students in Corwith-Wesley and the junior high in Lu Verne. This type of sharing came to be known as whole-grade sharing. In 1985-86 ten schools began whole-grade sharing, and that number jumped to 20, 42, 56, and 84 over the next four years. The greatest number of whole-grade sharing districts was reached in 1992-93, when 121 districts were functioning under such agreements.

Reorganization began to follow whole-grade sharing, with the largest number of mergers effective July 1, 1993. On that date 41 districts consolidated, for a reduction of 21 districts. In 1994-95 there will be 390 districts, with 354 of them operating high schools. This annual statistical report is provided to help school officials and citizens monitor the changes that have taken place.

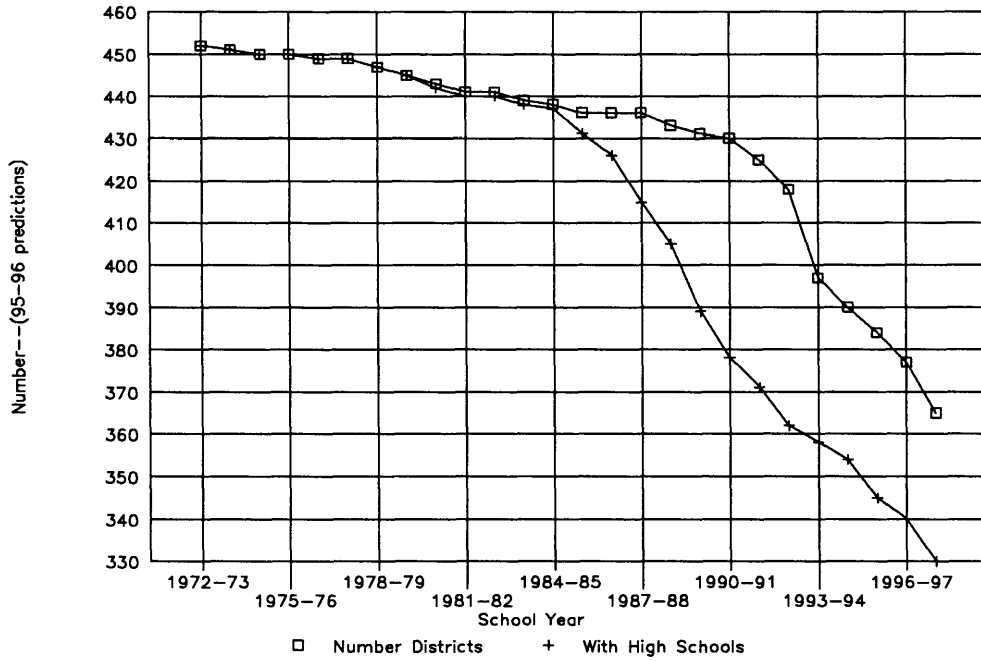
