## **EVALUATING RESULTS** THROUGH DATA





ECI uses the Results-Based Accountability™ (RBA) framework for evaluating the results of the initiative. In Iowa Iaw, the ECI Initiative has five desired results for improving the quality of life in Iowa for young children and their families.

#### **Statewide Indicators**

ECI uses measures, called statewide indicators, to determine progress made toward achieving the result areas. Statewide indicators are population measurements and are usually collected by public agencies. Both the ECI State Board and ECI area boards select statewide indicators to evaluate progress toward the five state result areas.

The information that follows provides trend data for statewide indicators adopted by the ECI State Board. In FY22 ECI utilized a revised Tool K(B) that includes updated indicators, definitions, and data sources based on the best available data.

The IA Data Drive (https://i2d2. iastate.edu/ia-data-drive) will continue to be a valuable data dashboard with its first launch in FY22. Appendix B of the IA Data Drive User's Manual provides additional information regarding ECI Indicator descriptions, numerator, source, and available URL.









#### **Immunized Children**






#### **Infant Mortality**



#### **Beginning Reading Skills**


Percent of kindergarten students proficient by kindergarten literacy assessment

Women age 15-50 with a birth in the past 12 months by educational attainment





Percent of minor children (19 years old and under) with health coverage by income and poverty level



Percent of unemployed individuals



#### **Children in Poverty**


Children under six years of age living in poverty



#### **Homelessness Count**







Children 0-5 years old



#### **Domestic Violence Rate**


Domestic abuse rate





Percent of households with children under age 6 and all parents in the household are in the workforce


