

(Live Births of less than 2,500 grams)




Percent of 2-year-olds with up-to-date immunizations




Dental Services

Dental Services



- 22 of 38 ECI Areas supported Dental Services. Through planning processes, local boards expand services to increase the chances of children being healthy and successful
- 15,191 Children were served
- 90% of children served were cavity free

Prenatal and Postnatal Services



- 5 of 38 ECI Areas supported Prenatal/ Postnatal Services
- 364 Children were served (including prenatal)
- \$185 average cost per child of ECI funds

Health Prevention Services



- 9 of 38 ECI Areas supported General Health Services
- 16,823 Children were served
- \$15 average cost per child of ECI funds



Educational Attainment of Women age 15-50 with a birth in the past 12 months




Children entering kindergarten who have no obvious dental problems

Percent of Students Entering Kindergarten Who Have No Obvious Dental Problems




Early Literacy Skills

Tuition Assistance



- 35 of 38 ECI Areas supported Tuition Assistance. Based on their community planning, local boards strive to fill gaps and expand services to support access for children be ready for school.
- 2,618 Children were served
- 92% children are demonstrating age-appropriate skills

Scholarship Coordination



- 24 of 38 ECI Areas supported Scholarship Coordination
- 2,347 Applications Processed
- 374 Preschool programs participated

Literacy



- 5 of 38 ECI Areas supported stand alone literacy programs
- 1,825 Children were served within 1,503 families
- 1,413 or 77% of the children served were reported to be using new words

Transportation



- 19 of 38 ECI Areas supported Transportation Services
- 671 Children were served
- \$333,140 ECI funds were used for these services

Early Care and Education Supportive Services

- 22 of 38 ECI Areas supported ECE Supportive Services (i.e. consultation, curriculum supports, business supports, etc.)
- 2,608 Children were served
- 131 programs were supported

Number of licensed and registered child care slots



Percent of households with children under age 6 and all parents in the workforce



Percent of Households with Children under Age 6 and All Parents in the Workforce




Quality Early Learning Environments

Child Care Nurse Consultants



- 31 of 38 ECI Areas supported a CCNC
- 1,461 programs participated
- 7,155 individual visits were conducted
- 586 children with special health care needs were able to stay in the same program

Quality Improvement



- 29 of 38 ECI Areas supported Quality Improvement for Early Learning Environments
- 877 programs received support

Crisis and Emergency Care



- 4 of 38 ECI Areas supported Crisis and Emergency Care
- 246 families and 350 children were served
- 43% of the children served were screened for developmental delays

Resource Library



- 1 of 38 ECI Areas supported a Resource Library
- 36 items were checked out
- 16 programs utilized the resource library

WAGE\$



- 5 of 38 ECI Areas supported the WAGE\$ program
- 146 professionals participated
- 84% of the participants worked at an ECE program rated 3+ on the QRS



Percent of Children under age 6 in Poverty




The percent of unemployed persons



Child Deaths due to Unintentional Injuries




Child Deaths Due to Unintended Injuries

Car Seat Safety



- 4 of 38 ECI Areas supported Car Seat Safety Checks
- 106 Children were served
- 8% of the car seats were properly installed prior to safety check, as reported by technician

Coordinated Intake



- 5 of 38 ECI Areas supported a local Coordinated Intake to increase collaboration, better meet family needs, and reduce possible duplication of services
- 1,477 families utilized the service
- 1,718 individual intakes were conducted

Public Awareness



- 6 of 38 ECI Areas supported public awareness activities
- 9,466 families were reached through 230 activities
- \$100,823 ECI funds supported activities




Incidence of confirmed child abuse for children 5 years old and under

Programs demonstrating adherence to quality standards as determined by an external review



Percent of all births to mothers under age 20



Parent Education



- 16 of 38 ECI Areas supported Parent Education programs
- ECI uses funds to give parents the tools they need to raise, healthy, successful children by providing education and resources through programs that increase parents' knowledge of children's development and positive parenting practices
- 20,710 group-based education meetings
- 77% of participating families improved or maintained healthy functioning, problem solving and communication

Home Visitation



- 38 of 38 ECI Areas supported Home Visitation services
- 79,501 home visits were conducted
- 90% of the participating families improved or maintained healthy family functioning and problem solving
- 61% of all families served were at 100% of FPL or lower
