Explanation of Data

The following report is divided into two parts labeled Part 1 and Part 2. The following is an explanation of the heading for each column:

PART 1:

- Column 1. State Share: The per cent of net reimbursable expenditures that is computed to be paid from State Equalization Aid before any pro-rate must be made of State Equalization Aid payments. Net reimbursable expenditures are reimbursable expenditures less the funds a district will receive from the Basic School Tax Equalization Fund.
- Column 2. Uniform County Mills 1967-68: The uniform millage spread on all taxable property within a county school system. This mill levy is that necessary to raise 40 per cent of the askings of all school districts within the county school system.
- Column 3. Additional Mills 1967-68: The mills levied on the property of the individual school district to raise the money necessary after taking into account funds from the Basic School Tax Equalization Fund, the State Equalization Fund, receipts from other sources, and any unencumbered balance to apply.
- Column 4. Actual Total General Fund Mills 1967-68: The total of columns 2 and 3.
- Column 5. General Fund Mills 1966-67: The total General Fund Mills levied for the 1966-67 school year. This is a comparable figure for 1967-68 found in column 4.
- Column 6. Mills Per Old Aids 1967-68: The estimated mills that would have been levied for the 1967-68 school year had the old aid program been continued unchanged.
- Column 7. Difference in Mills Plus or Minus: The difference between the actual mills for the 1967-68 budget (column 4) and the mills which would have existed under the old aid program (column 6).

PART 2:

- Column 1. Actual A. D. M. 1966-67: The actual average daily membership reported by the school district for the 1966-67 school year.
- Column 2. State Aid Per Pupil Paid 1966-67: The total amount of state funds distributed by the Department of Public Instruction for reimbursement on 1966-67 operating expenditures divided by the A. D. M. for 1966-67.
- Column 3. Projected A. D. M. 1967-68: The 1966-67 average daily membership multiplied by the average per cent of change for the three years prior to 1967-68.
- Column 4. State Aid Per Pupil Paid 1967-68: The total amount of state funds distributed by the Department of Public Instruction plus the district's share of the state income tax collected divided by the projected average daily membership.
- Column 5. Ag Paid Per Pupil: The agriculture land tax payment to the school district divided by the projected average daily membership.

- Column 6. Actual Pupil Reimbursement: The district average per pupil reimbursable expenditure per pupil in average daily membership for 1966-67.
- Column 7. Allowable Reimbursement Per Pupil: The district reimbursable expenditure per pupil for 1966-67 increased by the state allowable growth factor for 1967-68 of 13.6433 per cent.
- Column 8. Proposed Reimbursement Per Pupil: The proposed reimbursable expenditure for the district for the 1967-68 school year divided by the projected average daily membership.
- Column 9. Amount Prop Exceeds Allow: The amount in total dollars the proposed reimbursable expenditures for 1967-68 exceed the district's allowable reimbursable expenditures. Computed by obtaining the difference between column 8 and column 7 and multiplying by the projected average daily membership. A figure followed by "-" indicates the district proposed to spend less than the total allowable.
- Column 10. % Prop Exceeds Allow: The difference between the district's per cent of increase from actual to proposed and the state allowable growth factor. This figure is obtained by computing the per cent of increase from actual per pupil reimbursable expenditure to proposed per pupil reimbursable expenditure and subtracting from this per cent of increase the allowable growth factor of 13.6433.
