To Apply

Contact your county Iowa State University Extension office by mid-January. The phone number for your county is on the back. Request the application form for the Iowa Youth Technology Team. Be sure to ask for the county application deadline.





Criteria for Selection/Application

- Is a freshman, sophomore, or junior in high school when applying
- Has or can easily obtain access to a computer, the Internet, and e-mail
- Is interested in information technology (computers, Internet, etc.)
- Is interested in volunteering time and talents
- Possesses skills in one or more of the following areas:
 - Working with/training people
 - Public presentation and speaking
 - Editing
 - Organization
 - High level computer skills
 - U Web page development/design
 - Photography
 - Graphic design
 - Video/animation
 - Drawing/art
 - 🗌 Audio
 - Computer programming
 - Conflict resolution
- Two letters of recommendation (Preferably one recommendation should come from a local school teacher or administrator.)
- Up to five pages of written support materials or up to 10-minute video or audio tape
- The area selection committee also may conduct a face-to-face interview.

Membership Responsibilities

- Attend four face-to-face meetings.
 - The first meeting will be from Sunday, May 7 through Monday, May 8, 2000.
 - The second meeting will take place from Monday, June 19 through Thursday, June 22 at the Iowa 4-H Youth Conference.
 - The third and fourth meeting dates will be set up by the technology team members.
- Commit to one year with an opportunity to reapply if interested.
- Demonstrate high standards of ethical behavior while using technology.
- Help develop the state technology team plan of work.
- Work with teens on the State 4-H Council to improve the state youth 4-H web page.
- Be a 4-H ambassador (need not be in 4-H now).
- Help promote technology at the Iowa 4-H Youth Conference to be held in Ames during the second face-to-face meeting.
- Participate in bimonthly distance communication as needed (includes e-mail, web chats, ICN, etc.).
- Develop and carry out an individual plan of work.
- Commit to 1–2 hours of work each week outside of face-to-face meetings.
