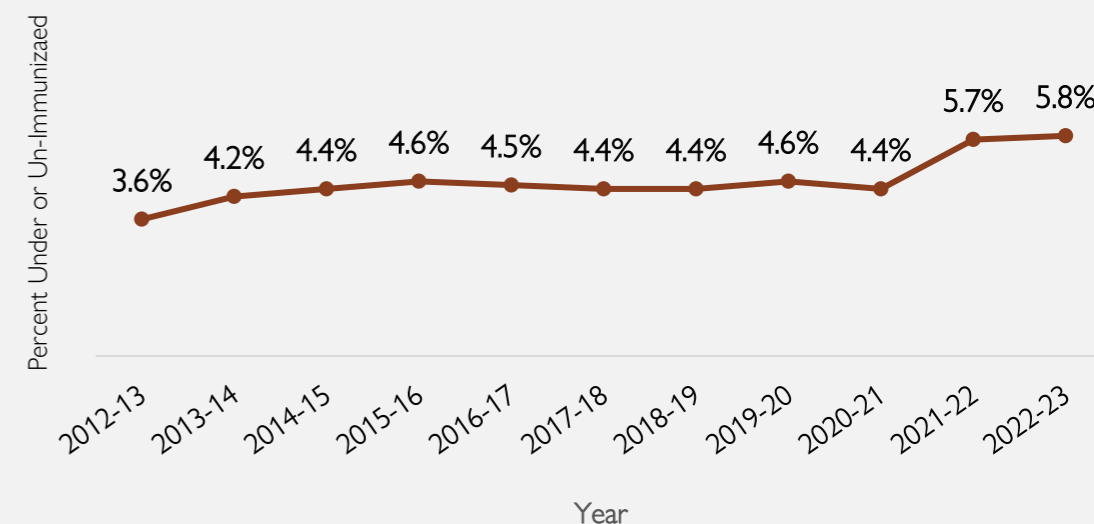

Changes Over Time: Under or Un-Immunized Students

The percent of under or un-immunized students increased 0.1% (528 students) from last year and has steadily been increasing since 2012.

It is important to continue efforts in maintaining high vaccination rates in order to prevent the spread of vaccine-preventable diseases.

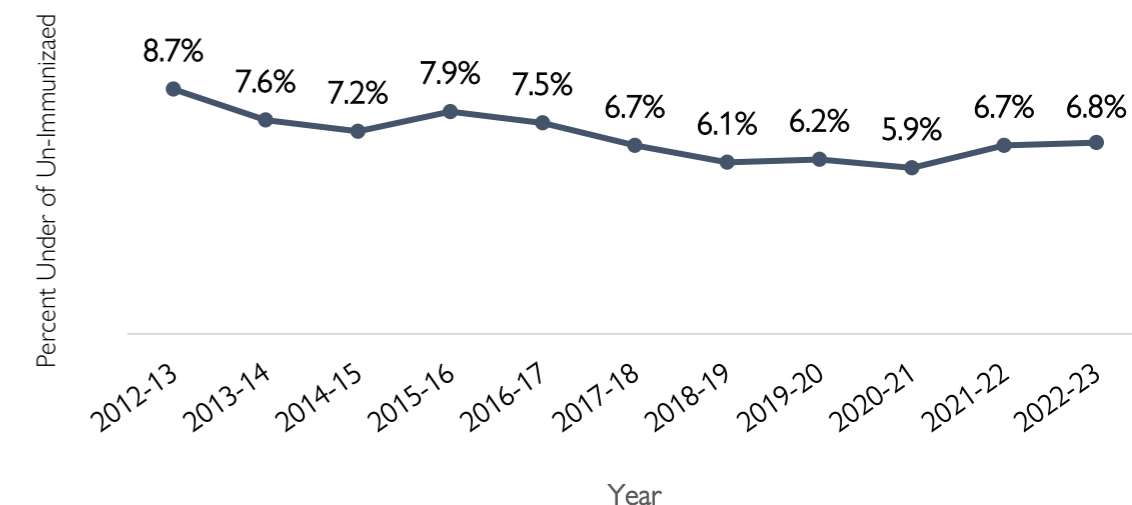

Changes Over Time: Under or Un-Immunized Children

Although the percent of under or un-immunized children in licensed child care has steadily decreased over the last 10 years, there has been a 0.9% increase (1,656 children) in the percent of under or un-immunized children over the last two years.
