#### **Estimated Livestock Returns**

Each month, Extension outlook economist John Lawrence calculates profits based on current market conditions for cattle, feeder pigs, and market hogs. Livestock Feeding Projections include estimated break-evens and projected profits or losses from feeding feeder pigs, and feeder calves, steers, and heifers purchased and fed at prevailing prices.
