



Figure 1: Total lowa Labor Force, 14 years and over




Figure 2: Iowa's Employment in Agriculture, Forestry and Fisheries, 1950, 1960, and Projected to 1980







Figure 3: Iowa's Employment in Construction












Figure 5: Iowa's Employment in Manufacturing-Nondurable Goods










Figure 6: Iowa's Employment in Other Manufacturing-Not Specified










Figure 7: Iowa's Employment in Transportation, Communication and Public Utilities








Figure 8: Iowa's Employment in Wholesale and Retail Trade




Figure 9: Iowa's Employment in Finance, Insurance and Real Estate




Figure 10: Iowa's Employment in Business and Repair Service




Figure 11: Iowa's Employment in Personal Services




Figure 12: Iowa's Employment in Entertainment Services




Figure 13: Iowa's Employment in Professional and Related Services




Figure 14: Iowa's Employment in Educational Services




Figure 15: Iowa's Employment in Public Administration




Figure 16: Iowa's Employment in Industry Not Elsewhere Reported







Figure 17: Iowa's Employment in Mining

Figure 18: Total lowa Labor Force, 14 years and over










Figure 19: Iowa's Employment in Professional, Technical and Related









Figure 20: lowa's Employment in Managers and Related










Figure 21: Iowa's Employment in Clerical and Related










Figure 24: lowa's Employment in Operatives and Related




Figure 25: Iowa's Employment in Service (incl. priv. household)




Figure 26: Iowa's Employment in Farmers and Farm Managers




Figure 27: Iowa's Employment in Farm Laborers and Foremen




Figure 28: Iowa's Employment in Total Farm Labor Force




Figure 29: Iowa's Employment in Laborers







Figure 30: Iowa's Employment In Occupation Not Elsewhere Reported




Figure 41: lowa's Employment in Professional and Technical, Male Labor Force
