THE MANY VOLUNTEER OPPORTUNITIES

- **PARKS VOLUNTEER:** help with special events; assist with maintenance; provide natural history programs; work on trails; serve as campground host.
- **FISH & WILDLIFE VOLUNTEER:** assist in preserving, maintaining and establishing habitat and nesting boxes; help with prairie restoration.
- **AIR QUALITY VOLUNTEER:** help increase community awareness of leaf and garbage burning alternatives.

- **LAND MANAGEMENT VOLUNTEER:** assist with prairie brush control; help with tree and shrub planting; help control invasive species.
- **FORESTS AND PRAIRIES VOLUNTEER:** collect nuts for seedlings; provide tree care programs; harvest prairie seed; plant trees.
- **OUTDOOR SAFETY EDUCATOR:** become a volunteer instructor for hunter education or recreational vehicle safety.
- **ENERGY PROGRAMS VOLUNTEER:** help increase awareness of energy saving opportunities.
- **WASTE MANAGEMENT VOLUNTEER:** assist in recycling/composting projects; trash cleanups; storm sewer stenciling.
- **WATER QUALITY VOLUNTEER:** train through the IOWATER and Adopt-a-Stream programs for projects in your area.

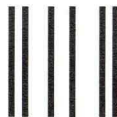

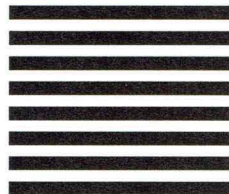
