
2023 HIV and Hepatitis Prevention Program Snapshot Integrated Testing Services: HIV Screening


The Integrated Testing Services (ITS) program administered **10,458** HIV tests across 12 participating agencies in 2023.

This represents an increase in testing of 4% from 2022, and is 9% higher than the five-year average of 9,574 tests per year.

The rate of people newly diagnosed with HIV in ITS settings decreased in 2023 resulting in a 0.18% positivity rate, lower than the five-year positivity rate of 0.24%.



Data are not de-duplicated. Numbers represent test encounters not unique individuals.



The proportion of individuals newly diagnosed with HIV in lowa identified through ITS program activities decreased to 14% of new diagnoses in 2023 (as compared to 23% in 2022 and 11% over the five-year period represented).

Overall, Iowa has seen a total increase in newly reported HIV infections of 48% between 2019 and 2023.
