PROCEDURAL HISTORY


On May 15, 2002, a hearing was conducted on the Davenport Community School District Budget Appeal. The hearing was before a panel consisting of Stephen Larson, Executive Officer III and presiding hearing officer, Office of the State Treasurer; Stephen Ford, City Budget Supervisor, Department of Management; and Donna Kruger, Senior Auditor II, Office of the State Auditor.
