Recognizing the need for training for first responders and initial investigators in missing child cases, The National Center for Missing and Exploited Children (NCMEC) has developed a specialized training program aimed at the swift and successful investigation of reports involving missing and abducted children. **Missing and Abducted Children: A Survival Program for First Responders and Initial Investigators**, is designed to provide critical information to those officers and investigators who will respond to a missing child report and whose knowledge, skill, and ability may make the difference between prompt recovery and a protracted investigation. In addition to reactive investigative techniques, attendees will also gain valuable proactive knowledge to better prepare them for encounters with potential child predators.

Topics Covered Include: Child Abduction, Family Abduction, Runaways, Media Relations, Sexual Predators, Incident Screening, Recovery Techniques, Investigative Resources, Agency Planning. Presented in a fast-paced format, this program is accentuated with high impact videos, case histories, investigative scenarios, and group participation exercises.

The Organization - Established in 1984 and funded by the US Office of Juvenile Justice and Delinquency Prevention, NCMEC serves as the nation’s clearinghouse for information on missing and exploited children. Since its inception, NCMEC approved presenters have provided training for more than 150,000 law enforcement, criminal justice, and child protection professionals in the United States and abroad.

The Presenter – This program will be presented by Stephen Steidel, NCMEC’s Associate Director of Training. Prior to his affiliation with NCMEC, Mr. Steidel served with the Suffolk County (NY) Police Department, where he held a number of investigative and supervisory positions including commander of the Missing Persons Bureau. In addition to his duties as a NCMEC trainer, Mr. Steidel also assists local law enforcement agencies in areas such as the design of effective policies and procedures, the development of regional response plans, and other efforts aimed at enhancing an agency’s overall response to cases of missing or abducted children.

The Cost to Agencies – *No cost for training* – agencies will need to provide transportation, meals and lodging.

Halloween Safety Tips



KNOW THE RULES...SAFETY TIPS FOR HALLOWEEN

1. Do not allow a child to go Trick or Treating alone. Be sure older children **TAKE A FRIEND** and an **ADULT** accompanies young children.
2. Be certain to accompany young children to the door of every house they approach.
3. Be certain that parents are familiar with every house and all people from which the children receive treats.
4. Children should be cautioned that they should **NOT** enter any home without prior permission from their parents.
5. Children should be cautioned not to approach any vehicle, occupied or not, unless they know the owner and are accompanied by a parent.
6. Make sure that all children carry a glow stick or wear reflective clothing.
7. When using facial masks, make sure that children can see and breathe properly and easily.
8. All costumes and masks should be clearly marked as flame resistant.
9. Children should be warned to **NEVER** approach any house that is not well lit and does not have a porch or outside light on.
10. Children should be cautioned to remember any suspicious incidents and report them to their parents and/or the proper official.
11. Children should be cautioned to run away from people who try to trick them with special treats.
12. Children should be instructed to scream and make a scene if anyone tries to grab them or force them, in any way, to go with them.
13. Parents should inspect all treats and dispose of anything that seems to have been tampered with, has been opened, or is not wrapped.
14. A good alternative to Trick or Treating is for parents to organize parties at home, in schools, or in community centers.

Incident Type Key

- I - Involuntary** A person of any age who is missing under circumstances indicating that the disappearance was not voluntary, i.e., abduction or kidnapping.
- E -Endangered** A person of any age who is missing under circumstances indicating that his/her physical safety is in danger.
- D -Disabled** A person of any age who is missing and under proven physical/mental disability or is senile, thereby subjecting himself/herself or others to personal and immediate danger.
- V - Catastrophe** A person of any age who is missing after a catastrophe, (i.e., victims of disasters, such as tornadoes, etc.)
- K - Familial Kidnap** A minor who is missing and has been declared unemancipated as defined by the laws of his/her state of residence and who has been abducted by non-custodial parent or relative.
- LW - Lost/Wandered Away** A minor who is lost or has wandered away. This category does not include those persons taken by force or runawa**Juvenile** A person who is missing and declared unemancipated as defined by the laws of his/her state of residence and does not meet any of the entry criteria for Disability, Endangered, Involuntary, Parental Abduction, or Lost or Wandered Away.
