**Column A: Enrollment**

**Column C: Treatment Needs** (status of oral health as indicated on student's valid Certificate of Dental Screening form)

- Number of students who Require Dental Care (tooth decay, white spot lesion, or gum infection is suspected)
- Number of students who Require Urgent Dental Care (obvious tooth decay, injury, severe infection or pain)
