<u>Supercharged Storytimes</u> is a curriculum from WebJunction designed to "provide training in how to intentionally apply research-based practices to boost early literacy in young children attending library storytime."



The State Library is pleased to announce that we'll be leading a cohort of 12-15 lowa librarians through six modules of the curriculum **from**September 6 - November 15. The training, discussions, and resources in this curriculum will *supercharge* your storytimes to make them even better!

At the end of the six sessions, cohort members will have the opportunity to share on a panel during the December Pop YS Live.

Librarians who successfully complete the program will be awarded **15 hours** of CE Credit towards their endorsement renewal.
