The Iowa Small Library Association (ISLA) is offering two scholarships to any of its ISLA members to help defray expenses to attend the lowa Library Association fall conference. This year's conference is in Des Moines October 9-11, 2024. Each of these scholarships

Eligible expense reimbursement includes conference registration, hotel accommodations, and mileage. Assuming there will be more than two applicants, the winners will be determined through a random drawing.
