### **Child Custody BONDS: Another Tool to Help Prevent Abduction**

The fourth District Court of Appeals recently sued to allow Mohammed Ardestani to take his children to visit family in Iran, despite objections from the children's mother, his ex-wife, Lori Long. Ardestani, who has dual citizenship in Iran and the US, and his ex-wife, share legal custody of their children.

Although Long claims that throughout their marriage Ardestani threatened to take the children to Iran and never return, the court found that Long could not prove that Ardestani now has the intent to stay in Iran with the children. Long fears that if Ardestani takes the children to Iran and stays there, she will have no legal recourse to get them back, as Iran is not a signer

of the Hague Convention on the Civil Aspects of International Child Abduction.

As reports of cases like these continue to grow, state legislatures, like in Wisconsin, have taken action to try to prevent the increase in family abduction in the United States. The Wisconsin legislature is in the process of passing a bill that will prohibit a parent who has physical custody of a child from taking that child to a foreign country which is not part of the Hague Convention, without the permission of the other parent. This bill would restrict parents like Ardestani from taking their children out of the country without the permission of the other parent.

In situations where parental abduction is a real possibility, parents like Long find themselves helpless. Where there is little or no prior concrete evidence of abduction or an attempted abduction, parents face the tough challenge of trying to prevent such abuse against their children.

Another frightening thought for left-behind parents in the event of an abduction is the prospect of not having the financial resources to mount a meaningful search and recovery effort. Parents who abduct their children generally have nothing to lose financially by breaking the court-ordered terms of their custody decree. For years NCEC has sought to remedy this situation by recommending and advocating the use of a bond to help ensure the parents' compliance with the visitation terms of a couple's custody decree. NCMEC has worked for more than a decade to broaden the use of bonds as a prevention tool to help provide much-needed funds to a left-behind parent in the event of a parental abduction.

While NCMEC is committed to the use of bonds in these situations, parents had a difficult time identifying insurance companies and agents willing to underwrite such a high-risk obligation. The newly formed partnership between NCMEC and the Professional Bail Agents of the United States (PBUS) has created the Child Custody Bond for use by parents and the family-law community in helping to ensure compliance with the visitation terms of a custody decree. The PBUS member agents and companies are well positioned to accept such a proposal from NCMEC as they have many years of experience dealing with high-risk, specialized obligations. PBUS is conducting an informational and training program nationwide to educate its agents and insurance companies about the Child custody Bond and its implementation. The goal of the NCMEC/PBUS partnership is to make the Child Custody Bond accessible to parents who may need this bond to help protect their children against parental abduction.

The Child Custody Bond is ordered by the judge hearing the custody case and filed by either one or both parents to help secure the return of a child from scheduled parenting time or the production of the child for scheduled time with a parent. The bond may be used to help secure either domestic or international visitation plans.

If there has been evidence of prior noncompliance with the visitation terms of the custody decree or there is suspicion that there may be interference with the custody and visitation terms, it would be wise for the concerned parent to, through counsel, request that a Child Custody Bond be set and ordered by the court. The judge who is hearing the case will be responsible for setting the amount of the bond. The court should set the bond at a dollar amount large enough to not only discourage abduction and help ensure compliance, but also would consider a sum reasonable enough to fund a search for the child in the event of an abduction. The expected range of most Child Custody Bonds is between \$10,000 and \$25,000 with international bonds set at a higher level.

Should the parent under bond fail to perform his or her duties as ordered by the court, the proceeds of the forfeited bond are then payable to the searching parent. These financial resources are used to provide investigative and legal support for the search and recovery of the child. Such resources are often the main obstacles faced by left-behind parents searching for their children. The bond may be ordered as part of the initial custody agreement or an amended condition of continued visitation.

It is hoped that when the Child Custody Bond is filed in a custody case, it will serve as a strong deterrent to subjecting children to this deeply traumatic breakup of their family. ## Amended Passport Procedures

In response to the continued increase in international child abduction, the US Congress has recently amended passport procedures for the issuance of passports for children younger than 14. The new requirement (66 FR 29904), effective as of July 2, 2001, requires the consent of both parents before a US passport will be issued to a child 14 years of age or younger. If the applying parent has sole custody of the child, proof, such as the child's birth certificate or a court order, must be presented. Similarly, if the second parent is unable to appear, a written statement of consent must be submitted from that parent. The requirement also presents a new opportunity to address the issue of

passport fraud. In addition the US Department of State's Passport Issuance Alert Program is still available to parents who are involved in a custody dispute or concerned about the possibility of an international child abduction. Once a child's name is entered into the alert system, the parent is notified if a passport is ordered for his or her child. **Incident Type Key**

- I - Involuntary** A person of any age who is missing under circumstances indicating that the disappearance was not voluntary, i.e., abduction or kidnapping.
- E -Endangered** A person of any age who is missing under circumstances indicating that his/her physical safety is in danger.
- D -Disabled** A person of any age who is missing and under proven physical/mental disability or is senile, thereby subjecting himself/herself or others to personal and immediate danger.
- V - Catastrophe** A person of any age who is missing after a catastrophe, (i.e., victims of disasters, such as tornadoes, etc.)
- K - Familial Kidnap** A minor who is missing and has been declared unemancipated as defined by the laws of his/her state of residence and who has been abducted by non-custodial parent or relative.
- LW - Lost/Wandered Away** A minor who is lost or has wandered away. This category does not include those persons taken by force or runaways.
- J - Juvenile** A person who is missing and declared unemancipated as defined by the laws of his/her state of residence and does not meet any of the entry criteria for Disability, Endangered, Involuntary, Parental Abduction, or Lost or Wandered Away.
