Fall is a great time to plant many species of trees and shrubs. The Iowa DNR State Forest Nursery offers fall delivery in November for most hardwoods and shrubs. Visit our online store at Nursery.lowaDNR.gov to view seedling varieties and to place your fall order.

Properly planted trees have a better opportunity for a long, healthy life. Here's a few tips on how to properly plant a tree:

- Select a species that matches your site's growing conditions (i.e. soil type, soil drainage, available growing space, full sun or shade, etc.).
- Always call lowa One Call-811 before you start digging to locate any underground utilities.
- Remove top soil from the original root ball until you can see the first lateral root. This first main root should be just below soil grade when planting.
