Iowa's congressional delegation. The Commission recommended that a letter requesting members of Iowa's congressional delegation to contact the National Park Service concerning their support for this study be drafted and sent. The members on the Commission indicated their desire to continue to seek a solution to the boundary questions which exist between the states of Iowa and Nebraska and expressed the hope that future meetings with the Nebraska Commission might occur.
