Wi-Fi Hotspots Now Eligible for E-Rate Funding

Starting in Funding Year 2025, Wi-Fi hotspots and mobile wireless internet services that can be used off-premises will be eligible for E-Rate funding. This will allow libraries to start or continue Wi-Fi hotspot lending programs for patron checkouts.
