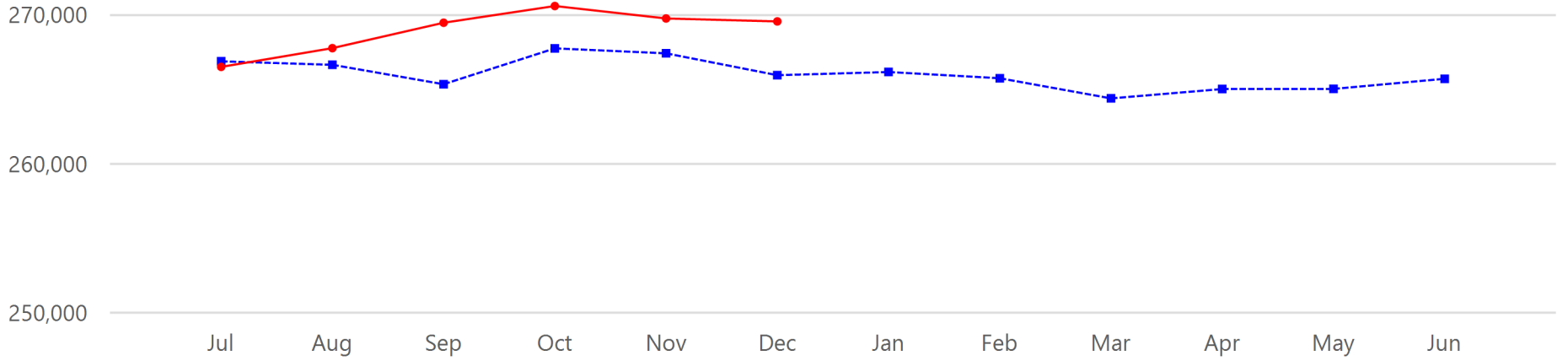

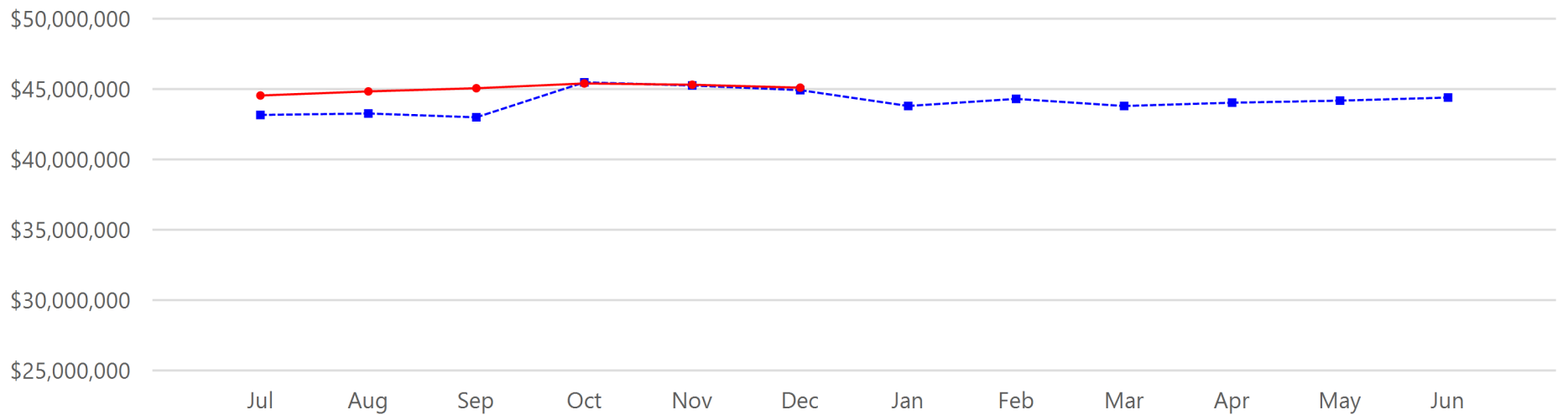
## Total SNAP Recipients
