Auditor of State Rob Sand today released the State University of Iowa's Single Audit Report for the year ended June 30, 2024. The report covers the expenditure of federal funds by the State University of Iowa and includes a review of internal controls and compliance with federal laws and regulations.

FINANCIAL HIGHLIGHTS:

The State University of Iowa expended approximately \$649.2 million of federal funds in fiscal year 2024, an increase of approximately \$5.7 million, or less than 1% from the prior year. Funding directly related to the Coronavirus Aid, Relief, and Economic Security Act (CARES) and American Rescue Plan Act (ARPA) accounted for approximately \$16.4 million, a decrease of approximately \$25.2 million. Funds directly related to the CARES and ARPA programs included an \$11.1 million for the Education Stabilization Fund program and \$1.2 million for Prevention of Diseases, Disability and Death by Infectious Diseases.

Research and Development Cluster expenditures, including approximately \$4.1 million related to CARES and ARPA, were approximately \$378.1 million, or 5.9% over the prior year. Expenditures for the Research and Development Cluster included approximately \$45.7 million for Assistance Listing Number 43.RD Unknown Title from the National Aeronautics and Space Administration, approximately \$31.0 million for Assistance Listing Number 93.853 Extramural Research Programs in the Neurosciences and Neurological Disorders, approximately \$23.9 million for Assistance Listing Number 93.323 Epidemiology and Laboratory Capacity for Infectious Diseases (ELC), and approximately \$23.8 million for Assistance Listing Number 93.855 Allergy and Infectious Diseases Research.

Student Financial Aid Cluster expenditures were approximately \$233.4 million, or an 2.0% increase over the prior year. Expenditures included approximately \$191.2 million for Assistance Listing Number 84.268 Federal Direct Student Loans and approximately \$20.9 million for Assistance Listing Number 84.063 the Federal Pell Grant Program.

AUDIT FINDINGS:

The report disclosed no findings pertaining to the federal programs for the year ended June 30, 2024.

To the Members of the Iowa Board of Regents:

We are pleased to submit the Single Audit Report for the State University of Iowa, Iowa City, Iowa (University of Iowa) for the year ended June 30, 2024. The audit of compliance was conducted in accordance with U.S. generally accepted auditing standards (GAAS), the standards applicable to financial audits contained in Government Auditing Standards, issued by the Comptroller General of the United States, and Title 2, U.S. Code of Federal Regulations, Part 200, Uniform Administrative Requirements, Cost Principles and Audit Requirements for Federal Awards (Uniform Guidance).

The Single Audit Report reflects federal expenditures of approximately \$649.2 million. There were no instances of noncompliance or material weaknesses in internal control relating to major programs. The Single Audit Report includes an unmodified opinion on the University of Iowa's compliance with requirements applicable to each of its major federal programs.

The University of Iowa's Financial Report for the year ended June 30, 2024 has been issued separately by the University. In addition, in accordance with Government Auditing Standards, our report on the University of Iowa's internal control over financial reporting and on our tests of its compliance with certain provisions of laws, regulations, contracts and grant agreements and other matters was issued under separate cover. Copies of these reports are available for review on the Auditor of State's website at Audit Reports – Auditor of State.

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Independent Auditor's Report on Compliance
for Each Major Federal Program, on Internal Control over Compliance
and Report on Schedule of Expenditures of Federal Awards
Required by the Uniform Guidance

To the Members of the Iowa Board of Regents:

Report on Compliance for Each Major Federal Program

Opinion on Each Major Federal Program

We have audited the State University of Iowa, Iowa City, Iowa's (University of Iowa) compliance with the types of compliance requirements identified as subject to audit in the U.S. Office of Management and Budget (OMB) Compliance Supplement that could have a direct and material effect on each of the University's major federal programs for the year ended June 30, 2024. The University of Iowa's major federal programs are identified in Part I of the accompanying Schedule of Findings and Questioned Costs.

In our opinion, the University of Iowa complied, in all material respects, with the compliance requirements referred to above that could have a direct and material effect on each of its major federal programs for the year ended June 30, 2024.

Basis for Opinion on Each Major Federal Program

We conducted our audit of compliance in accordance with auditing standards generally accepted in the United States of America (GAAS), the standards applicable to financial audits contained in Government Auditing Standards, issued by the Comptroller General of the United States, and the audit requirements of Title 2, U.S. Code of Federal Regulations, Part 200, Uniform Administrative Requirements, Cost Principles and Audit Requirements for Federal Awards (Uniform Guidance). Our responsibilities under those standards and the Uniform Guidance are further described in the Auditor's Responsibilities for the Audit of Compliance section of our report.

We are required to be independent of the University of Iowa and to meet our other ethical responsibilities, in accordance with relevant ethical requirements relating to our audit. We believe the audit evidence we have obtained is sufficient and appropriate to provide a basis for our opinion on compliance for each major federal program. Our audit does not provide a legal determination of the University of Iowa's compliance with the compliance requirements referred to above.

Responsibilities of Management for Compliance

Management is responsible for compliance with the requirements referred to above and for the design, implementation, and maintenance of effective internal control over compliance with the requirements of laws, statutes, regulations, rules and provisions of contracts or grant agreements applicable to the University of Iowa's federal programs.

Auditor's Responsibilities for the Audit of Compliance

Our objectives are to obtain reasonable assurance about whether material noncompliance with the compliance requirements referred to above occurred, whether due to fraud or error, and express an opinion on the University's compliance based on our audit. Reasonable assurance is a high level of assurance but is not absolute assurance and therefore is not a guarantee that an audit conducted in accordance with GAAS, Government Auditing Standards and the Uniform Guidance will always detect material noncompliance when it exists. The risk of not detecting material noncompliance resulting from fraud is higher than for that resulting from error, as fraud may involve collusion, forgery, intentional omissions, misrepresentations, or the override of internal control. Noncompliance with the compliance requirements referred to above is considered material, if there is a substantial likelihood that, individually or in the aggregate, it would influence judgement made by a reasonable user of the report on compliance about the University of Iowa's compliance with the requirements of each major federal program as a whole.

In performing an audit in accordance with GAAS, Government Auditing Standards and the Uniform Guidance, we:

- Exercise professional judgement and maintain professional skepticism throughout the audit.
- Identify and assess the risks of material noncompliance, whether due to fraud or error, and design and perform audit procedures responsive to those risks. Such procedures include examining, on a test basis, evidence regarding the University of Iowa's compliance with the compliance requirements referred to above and performing other such procedures as we considered necessary in the circumstances.
- Obtain an understanding of the University of Iowa's internal control over compliance relevant to the audit in order to design audit procedures that are appropriate in the circumstances and to test and report on internal control over compliance in accordance with the Uniform Guidance, but not for the purpose of expressing an opinion on the effectiveness of the State University of Iowa's internal control over compliance. Accordingly, no such opinion is expressed.

We are required to communicate with those charged with governance regarding, among other matters, the planned scope and timing of the audit and any significant deficiencies and material weaknesses in internal control over compliance we identified during the audit.

Report on Internal Control Over Compliance

A deficiency in internal control over compliance exists when the design or operation of a control over compliance does not allow management or employees, in the normal course of performing their assigned functions, to prevent or detect and correct noncompliance with a type of compliance requirement of a federal program on a timely basis. A material weakness in internal control over compliance is a deficiency, or a combination of deficiencies, in internal control over compliance such that there is a reasonable possibility material noncompliance with a type of compliance requirement of a federal program will not be prevented or detected and corrected on a timely basis. A significant deficiency in internal control over compliance is a deficiency, or a combination of deficiencies, in internal control over compliance with a type of compliance requirement of a federal program that is less severe than a material weakness in internal control over compliance, yet important enough to merit attention by those charged with governance.

Our consideration of internal control over compliance was for the limited purpose described in the Auditor's Responsibilities for the Audit of Compliance section above and was not designed to identify all deficiencies in internal control over compliance that might be material weaknesses or significant deficiencies in internal control over compliance. Given these limitations, during our audit we did not identify any deficiencies in internal control over compliance that we consider to be material weaknesses, as defined above. However, material weaknesses or significant deficiencies in internal control over compliance may exist that were not identified.

Our audit was not designed for the purpose of expressing an opinion on the effectiveness of internal control over compliance. Accordingly, no such opinion is expressed.

The purpose of this report on internal control over compliance is solely to describe the scope of our testing of internal control over compliance and the results of that testing based on the requirements of the Uniform Guidance. Accordingly, this report is not suitable for any other purpose.

Report on the Schedule of Expenditures of Federal Awards Required by the Uniform Guidance

We have audited the financial statements of the business-type activities, and the fiduciary activities of University of Iowa as of and for the year ended June 30, 2024, and the related Notes to Financial Statements, which collectively comprise the University of Iowa's basic financial statements. We issued our report thereon dated December 13, 2024, which contained unmodified opinions on those financial statements. Our report includes a reference to other auditors who audited the financial statements of the University of Iowa Center for Advancement and Affiliate and the University of Iowa Health System. This report does not include the results of the other auditors' testing of compliance for each major federal program and internal control over compliance. Our audit was conducted for the purpose of forming opinions on the financial statements that collectively comprise the University's basic financial statements. The accompanying Schedule of Expenditures of Federal Awards is presented for purposes of additional analysis as required by the Uniform Guidance and is not a required part of the basic financial statements. Such information is the responsibility of management and was derived from and relates directly to the underlying accounting and other records used to prepare the basic financial statements. The information has been subjected to the auditing procedures applied in the audit of the basic financial statements and certain additional procedures, including comparing and reconciling such information directly to the underlying accounting and other records used to prepare the basic financial statements or to the basic financial statements themselves, and other additional procedures in accordance with GAAS. In our opinion, the Schedule of Expenditures of Federal Awards is fairly stated in all material respects in relation to the basic financial statements as a whole.

(1) Significant Accounting Policies

A. Reporting Entity

The reporting entity includes all University of Iowa departments and other entities included in the University's financial report except for the University of Iowa Center for Advancement and Affiliate and the University of Iowa Health System which are discretely presented component units.

B. Basis of Presentation

The accompanying Schedule of Expenditures of Federal Awards (Schedule) includes the federal award activity of the University of Iowa under programs of the federal government for the year ended June 30, 2024. The information in this Schedule is presented in accordance with the requirements of Title 2, U.S. Code of Federal Regulations, Part 200, Uniform Administrative Requirements, Cost Principles and Audit Requirements for Federal Awards (Uniform Guidance). Programs listed in the Assistance Listing (AL) are so identified. Programs not in the AL are identified as other federal assistance.

In accordance with the Uniform Guidance, federal financial assistance is defined as assistance which non-federal entities receive or administer in the form of grants, cooperative agreements, non-cash contributions or donations of property (including donated surplus property), direct appropriations, food commodities, loans, loan guarantees, interest subsidies, insurance and other assistance, but does not include amounts received as reimbursement for services rendered to individuals.

Because the Schedule presents only a selected portion of the operations of the University of Iowa, it is not intended to and does not present the financial position, changes in net position, or cash flows of the University of Iowa.

Type A programs, as defined by Uniform Guidance, are those programs for the University of Iowa which exceeded \$3,000,000 in federal awards expended during the year ended June 30, 2024.

C. Basis of Accounting

Expenditures reported on the Schedule are presented on the accrual basis of accounting. Such expenditures are recognized following the cost principles contained in the Uniform Guidance, wherein certain types of expenditures are not allowable or are limited as to reimbursement.

D. Indirect Cost Rate

The University of Iowa uses a federally negotiated indirect cost rate.

E. Grantees

Assistance received directly from the federal government is shown by the grantee receiving the funds. Assistance received from other entities is so noted.
