Auditor of State Rob Sand today released a report on the Iowa Veterans Home for the year ended June 30, 2023.

The Iowa Commission of Veterans Affairs, which consists of nine members appointed by the Governor and confirmed by the Senate, oversees the conduct and operations of the Iowa Veterans Home.

The Iowa Veterans Home, located in Marshalltown, Iowa, provides long-term health care for Iowa's aging, chronically ill, handicapped veterans and their dependents or surviving spouses. The annualized cost per resident was \$192,503 in fiscal year 2023, a 2.13% increase over the prior year. The average number of residents decreased from 399 in fiscal year 2022 to 390 in fiscal year 2023.

AUDIT FINDINGS:

Sand reported no finding related to the Iowa Veterans Home.

To the Members of the Iowa Commission of Veterans Affairs:

The Iowa Veterans Home (Home) is a part of the State of Iowa and, as such, has been included in our audits of the State's Comprehensive Annual Financial Report and the State's Single Audit Report for the year ended June 30, 2023.

In addition to these reports, we prepare a separate report of recommendations pertaining to each Department's internal control, compliance with statutory requirements and other matters when our audits disclose findings we believe should be brought to your attention. This report is to inform you our audits of the Iowa Veterans Home did not disclose any findings we believe were necessary to report for the year ended June 30, 2023.

Also, in accordance with Code of Iowa Chapter 11.5C, we received a letter dated August 27, 2024 from Representative Sue Cahill to determine if the receipt and expenditure of state funds by the department is consistent with the laws, rules, regulations and contractual agreements governing those funds. As a result, additional procedures were performed to address concerns with payroll and remodeling costs. No recommendations were added as a result of this review.

We have also included certain unaudited financial and other information on pages 4 through 6 of this report for the Iowa Veterans Home for the five years ended June 30, 2023, to report an average annualized cost per resident, as required by Section 11.28 of the Code of Iowa.

This report, a public record by law, is intended solely for the information and use of the officials and employees of the Iowa Veterans Home, citizens of the State of Iowa and other parties to whom the Iowa Veterans Home may report. This report is not intended to be and should not be used by anyone other than these specified parties.
