#### **Volunteer Iowa Awards Ceremony**

On Tuesday, April 30, the Volunteer Iowa Awards Ceremony was held at the Iowa State Capitol. Four individuals and two groups were inducted into the Iowa Volunteer Hall of Fame. Four individuals were honored at the ceremony, receiving the Excellence in Mentoring award.

The six Volunteer Hall of Fame inductees have contributed service over their lifetimes and have stepped up to answer urgent needs in their communities,

such as housing, food, insecurity, donation collection and redistribution, resettlement, and translation services, and cancer awareness in our state. They welcome and mentor newly arrived refugees; provide translation, shelter, food, and transport to those in need; organize health screenings, gift drives, and engaging activities for individuals with disabilities; collect and distribute household donations; and serve as pillars of service in their communities. They have gone above and beyond to ensure thousands of lowans have access to housing, food, and social connections; committed countless hours to community improvement activities and cultural enrichment; and answered the call for service wherever and however it is needed. Collectively, these honorees have raised hundreds of thousands of dollars for their causes, which range from Metastatic Breast Cancer Awareness; refugee resettlement; household and holiday donations; and fostering civic engagement and connection. Most importantly, they have shared the spirit of service with others, training and connecting volunteers to service opportunities, and giving them the tools to pay it forward.

The four individuals who received the 2024 Excellence in Mentoring awards have positively impacted the lives and families of the young people they mentor, as well as their own, often leading to a change in the trajectory of the lives of all involved. They have also actively and consistently recruited other mentors, growing the impact of mentoring in their communities.
