## Iowa AmeriCorps Update

Volunteer lowa received notification from the federal government late Friday, April 25 that half of the active AmeriCorps grants Americorps Volunteer lowa administers were to cease operations. These grants represent 43% of Iowa AmeriCorps State members in addition to

100% of AmeriCorps VISTA members. We are working with programs and members to mitigate impact to the largest extent possible and help AmeriCorps members effectively transition. Volunteer lowa has activated our lowa AmeriCorps member emergency fund to help members during this period of transition, and we are working with agency partners to try and ensure core services can continue.

# **Volunteer Iowa Awards** Ceremony

On Thursday, April 24, the Volunteer Iowa Awards Ceremony was held at the Iowa State Capitol. Five individuals and one group were inducted into the lowa Volunteer Hall of Fame. Two individuals were honored at the ceremony by receiving the Excellence in Mentoring award.



We honored six Volunteer Hall of Fame inductees who have contributed service in their communities including in health and hospice care, youth support and empowerment, library services and improvements, diabetes and cancer awareness, and support for our veterans in our state. They have organized health screenings and provided hospice and grief counseling. These volunteers have gone above and beyond, committing countless hours to community improvement activities and cultural enrichment, answering the call for service wherever and however it is needed.

The two individuals who received the 2025 Excellence in Mentoring awards have positively impacted the lives and families of the young people they mentor, as well as their own, often leading to a change in the trajectory of the lives of all involved. They have also actively and consistently recruited other mentors, growing the impact of mentoring in their communities.
