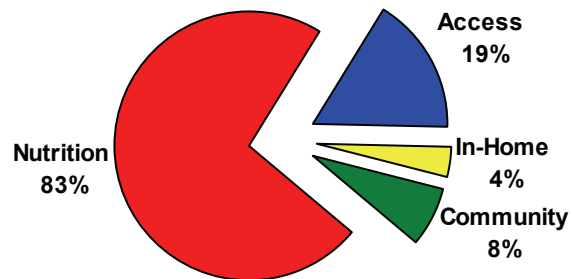

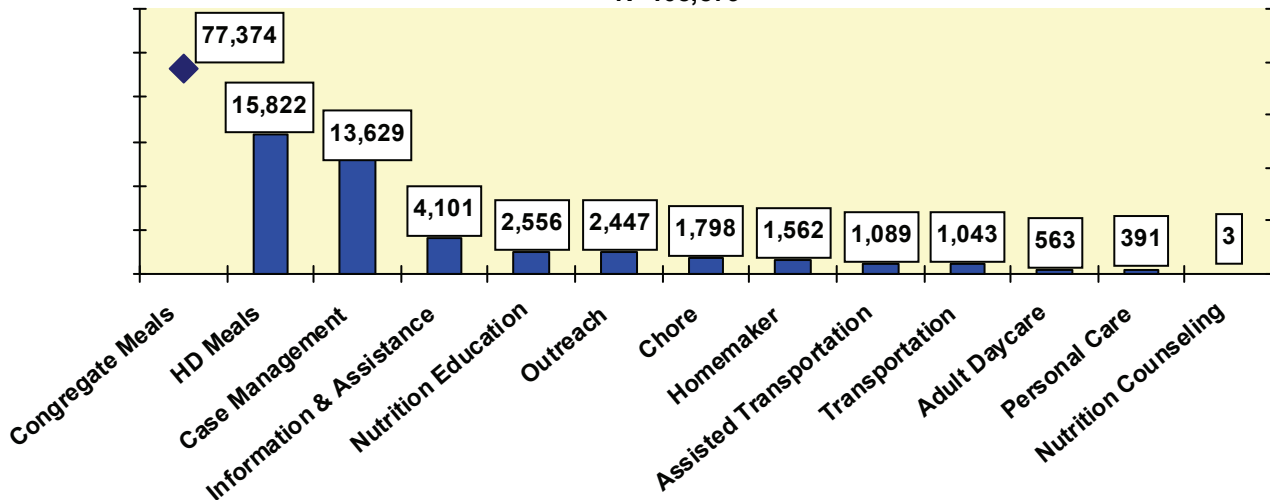

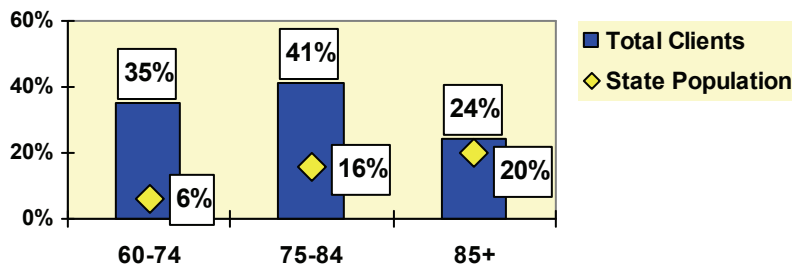

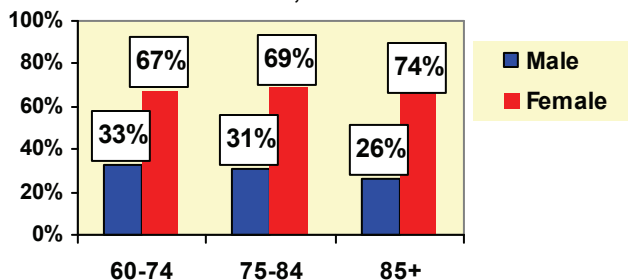

Age group that represents the highest % of Total Consumers

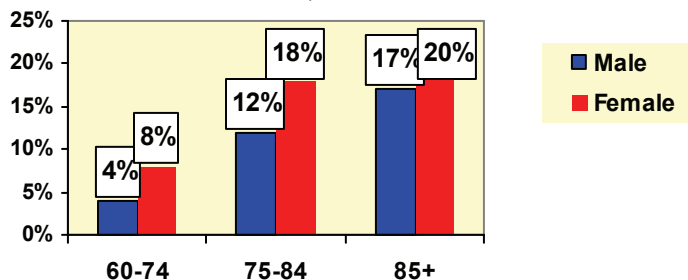

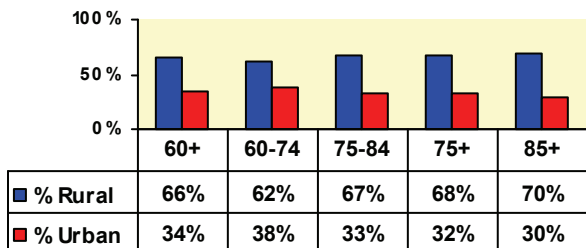
Unduplicated Consumers by Age Group & Gender

## Urban / Rural

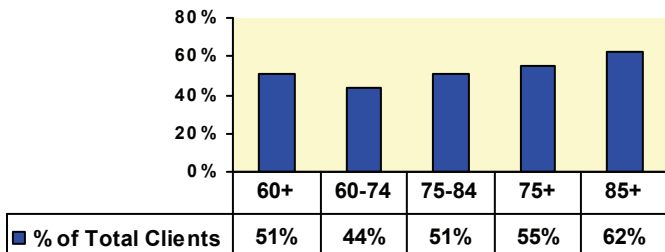
% of Total INAPIS Consumers

## Lives Alone

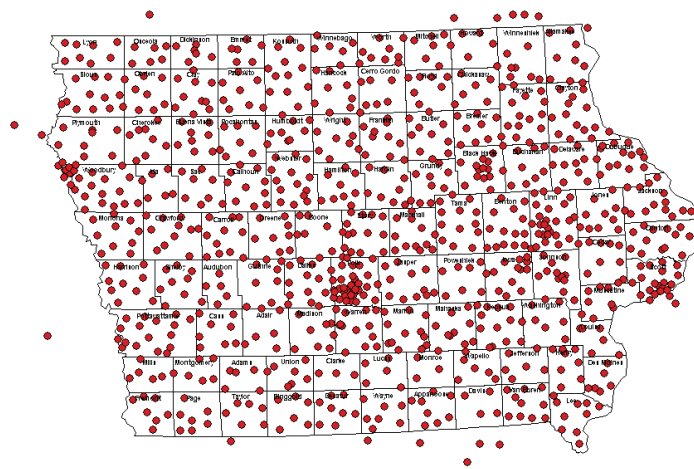
% of Total INAPIS Consumers
