Get Players Excited About Power Play With 10X Promo

Use Power Play 10X to get your players excited about playing Powerball!

Remind them that during the month of April, players who purchase Powerball® with the Power Play have a chance to multiply their nonjackpot prize by up to ten times!

During the promotion period, one of the four "5"s on the Power Play wheel will be substituted with a "10."



The promotion will run for at least eight drawings or until the "10" on the Power Play wheel is drawn at least once, whichever period is longer. If the "10" is drawn at least once during the promotion, then the 10X promotion will end with the final drawing on April 28.

Make sure players understand that, during this period, if the number "10" is drawn during a Power Play drawing, all Power Play prizes will be multiplied by 10 for eligible players who have purchased the Power Play option. That means, if a player wins the \$200,000 second tier prize with the Power Play on their ticket and the "10" comes up on the Power Play wheel, they'd win \$2 million! Jackpot prizes are not eligible for multiplication.

Action Briefs

Answers to Your Common Lottery Questions...

If I choose to receive my jackpot prize in payments and I die before the payment are all made, what happens to the remaining money?



If the winner should die, the

money would go to the winner's estate. The lottery will make future payments as determined by the estate or the court.

Is the lottery required to withhold money an individual may owe to the state?

Yes. The lottery is required by law to withhold income offsets from prize payments, such as amounts that may be owed to various government agencies. Prize recipients receive any balance remaining after application of the offset.

Pass Along More Helpful Tips to Players on Playing Pick 3

This is the second in a series of articles about playing Pick 3 and Pick 4.

Pick 3 Basics

How Much Can I Bet?

50 cents (box, front pair, back pair only), \$1, \$2, \$3, \$4, or \$5

How To Play: Choose a set of three numbers, each from 0 through 9.

Pick your own numbers or let the computer pick them by asking for an easy pick.

Select the play type:

Straight - match all numbers in the EXACT ORDER as drawn.

Box - match all three numbers IN ANY OR-DER.

Straight/BOX - match either exact and/or any order.

Front Pair - match the first two numbers in the EXACT ORDER as drawn.



Back Pair - match the last two numbers in the EXACT ORDER as drawn.

Purchase up to 14 consecutive drawings at a time. Drawings are held midday Monday through Saturday at 12:40 p.m. plus evenings at about 9:20 p.m. Monday through Sunday.

Ways to Win on Box Bet

The terms 3-way and 6way on the payout chart refer to how many ways a set of numbers can win on the box bet.

If two of the numbers on a ticket are identical, it becomes a 3-way play. This means there are three different ways a player can win on a box bet. For example, if the winning numbers were 211, a player could win with 112, 121 or 211. If all three numbers on a ticket are different, it becomes a 6-way play. This means there are six different ways a player can win on a box bet. If the winning numbers were 123, a player could win with: 123, 132, 231, 213, 321 or 312.
