# Miliford Woman Drives Away With New Tahoe Hybrid 'Set of Wheels' 

Nancy Fear of Milford drove away from the Iowa State Fair in a new, 2008 fourwheel drive Chevy Tahoe Hybrid ${ }^{\circledR}$, the grand-prize in the Iowa Lottery's "Set of Wheels" promotion.

Fear was selected as the grand-prize winner in the promotion drawing Aug. 7 on the Susan Knapp Amphitheater stage at the Iowa State Fairgrounds. Fear said she was excited to share the news with her adult children.
"They're waiting on a phone call, so

In July, eight Iowa Lottery players were selected as semifinalists in the lottery's "Set of Wheels" promotion and invited to the final drawing at the Iowa State Fair. During the State Fair event, semifinalists' names were drawn until the final name remaining in the drawing drum won the Tahoe Hybrid, the nation's first full-size hybrid sport utility vehicle. Fear's was the last name in the drum and she took home the vehicle, a $\$ 500$ ethanol card and $\$ 1,000$ cash. The Tahoe Hybrid vehicle package is valued at more than $\$ 79,000$.
Fear admitted after winning the SUV that she was so nervous, she might let her husband, Dan, drive it home from the Fair. After that, she's expecting some disbelief at first from friends and neighbors.
"I'll have all the neighbors over looking at my car," she said. "They're not going to believe it. I still can't believe it!"
Players entered the Set of Wheels promotion by visiting the Iowa Lottery's Web site at www.ialottery.com and entering the serial numbers from nonwinning $\$ 20$ "Set For Life" instant-scratch tickets. More than 12,000 entries were received during the entry period from May 23 through July 13 .

## Powerpall/hol Lotto Cheaperer By Dozer With Supper Sampler

With \$uper \$ampler from the Iowa Lottery, players may purchase Powerball ${ }^{\circledR}$ with Power Play ${ }^{\circledR}$ and Hot Lotto Sizzler ${ }^{\circledR}$ at a GREAT price.

Beginning Sunday, Aug. 24, when a player purchases three Powerball plays with the Power Play and three Hot Lotto Sizzler plays, they'll receive this $\$ 12$ value for just $\$ 10$ ! \$uper \$ampler ends Sept. 27.

Lotto retailers will see a "\$uper \$ampler" icon on their Extrema terminal's main screen beginning Aug. 24. When a player asks for the "\$uper \$ampler," simply touch this icon on the main screen (circled in Figure 1) and a box will pop up asking if you want to make the $\$ 10$ Powerball and Hot Lotto purchase (see Figure 2). Touch "yes" to complete the purchase, or "no" to cancel.
However, it's not essential to use the "\$uper \$ampler" icon on the main screen to take advantage of the promotion. Any $\$ 6$ Powerball/Power Play transaction on one ticket plus any $\$ 6$ Hot Lotto/Sizzler transaction on one ticket will trigger the discount for \$uper \$ampler during the promotion period. Plays may be either for a single drawing date or multi-draw. The player may choose their own numbers or ask for an easy pick.
Remember, when a player chooses the Power Play option, they can multiply their non-jackpot Powerball prizes from two to five times. Purchasing the Hot Lotto Sizzler with a Hot Lotto play allows the player to multiply their non-jackpot Hot Lotto prize by three times. Power Play and Hot Lotto Sizzler each cost $\$ 1$ in addition to the base $\$ 1$ play.

## Away for Weekennd, Mason City Woman Returns to Find She's Won \$100,000!

A Mason City woman had no idea when she went out of town for the weekend that she was holding a $\$ 100,000$-winning lottery ticket.

Judy Wickstrom claimed the jackpot for the July 24 Iowa's \$100,000 Cash Game drawing. She purchased the winning ticket at Hy-Vee, 2400 Fourth St. S.W. in Mason City.
"I just decided to go up [to the store] today and cash [my lottery tickets] and they were looking them over...," said Wickstrom when she claimed her prize. "I said, 'Now quit squabbling over money that belongs to me.' And they said ... 'You just won [\$100,002]."'
"There's nobody in that store ... [who doesn't] know that I won," she said.
Wickstrom said she'd just quit her job and was going to look for a new job next week.
"Well, forget that!" she laughed. "This pays off my bills.... [I] just turned 67 [on] July 20," she said. "It's time to relax."
